90 CALVES & STIRKS

Once again numbers still remaining short, with many buyers not filling their orders, but trade remaining very strong.

Top price for bulls once again was for a British Blue x bull calf selling for £402 on behalf of Mr WD Medland from Whitstone, who sold other British Blue x bulls for £392 and £375 and another at £355 for

Messrs K & J Chamberlain & Son from Shebbear.

Limousin bull calves saw a top price of £340 for Messrs FL Clark & Son from Clovelly and Charolais bulls to a top of £338 for Mr GCB Davis from Tiverton. Friesian bull calves to a top of £320 twice for some strong calves being sold by Messrs PR & EM Martin from Ashwater.

Heifer calves also sold well to a top of £342 for a Limousin x heifer on behalf of Messrs FL Clark & Son from Clovelly, who also sold a British Blue x heifer for £300. Messrs TJ & BE Cowley & Son from Ashwater also had a nice young British Blue x heifer selling for £295 and Mr WD Medland from Whitstone saw his best Limousin x heifer make £300. Charolais heifers topped at £295 for Mr GCB Davis with others at £290 for Messrs WS Jose & Son from North Tamerton.

Several again over 180p topping at 185p for two Simmentals from Messrs Jim & Louise Byrne, Ryme Intrinseca.

Several Friesians also sold well, British Friesian types topped at 169p for a 750 kilo steer from Mr P Harris, Highlands. Holstein types to 165p, several heavy steers over £1300 this week topping at £1367.10 for a 735 kilo Charolais from Mr Stan Hopper.
