123 CALVES & STIRKS

Another good entry of calves selling to a ring packed full of buyers.

Top price today went to a strong British Blue bull calf selling for £400 on behalf of Mr MT Braunton from Helland, closely followed by another British Blue x bull selling for £398 for Mr WD Medland from Whitstone, some younger British Blue x bulls selling for £350 twice for Messrs JR & MJ Ovens from Halwill and Messrs TJ & BE Cowley from Ashwater.

Charolais bull calves sold to £395 for Mr WM Northcott from Dizzard, with Limousin bulls selling to £360 for Messrs WJ & CC Bond from Buckland Brewer. Simmental x bull calves selling for £352 for Duchy College at Stoke Climsland, stronger Friesian x bulls selling up to £250 for Mr L Rocket from Bridestow, with the better younger bulls selling between £80 to £140.

British Blue x heifers sold to £300 for Mr WD Medland who also sold another at £275 and young British Blue x heifers for Mr MT Braunton sold for £275 and £270. Limousin heifers saw a top of £290 again for Mr WD Medland with Charolais heifers to £275 for Mr WM Northcott and Aberdeen Angus heifers to £250 again for

Duchy College. Only two stirks on offer with plenty of interest for a Simmental x steer selling to £470 and a Limousin x steer to £445 both for Messrs R Gorst & Son from North Petherwin.

The winner of this week's Genus prizes of £25 semen vouchers for the highest priced calves sired by a Genus bull was Mr J Ovens, Brendon, Halwill, with a British Blue Bull sired using Fertility Plus fetching £350, and he also won the heifer section with a British Blue Heifer sired using Fertility Plus this calf made £248.

27 OTM CATTLE

An entry of varied OTM's saw best beef cows to 142p/kg for a Charolais from Kevin Frain and best Holstein Friesian to 119p/kg. Overall average of 100p/kg (£683).

This week's winners of the Briarwoods Ltd Awards goes to Kevin Frain, Treciga, Truscott for a Charolais Cow OTM realising £1143.10, and for the fats a steer submitted by Mr CW Jennings, Holwell Farm, Higher Clovelly for a Limousin making £1332.

Another very strong trade saw the steers top at 191p for a Limousin from Mr Lewis Heard, Hartland whilst heifers topped at 168p for a 610 kilo Limousin from Mr P Sanders, Northway.
