109 CALVES & STIRKS

A larger entry this week selling to a continued strong trade.

Once again a British Blue x bull took top price of the day selling for £400 on behalf of Mr WD Medland from Whitstone. Young British Blue x bulls selling for £332 for MT Braunton from Helland and closely followed by another at £328 for Mr HJ Glessing from Pyworthy, many others selling in excess of £300.

Limousin x bulls sold to a top of £365 twice on behalf of Mr WD Medland followed by £360 for a smart Limousin x bull for Mr WS Bond from West Putford. Charolais

x bulls sold to £315 for Messrs WS Jose & Son from North Tamerton with another at £295 for the same vendor. A young Angus bull sold to £268 for Messrs KH & SA Toms from Meeth and £260 for Messrs BD & RM Scambler from Parkham. Holstein Friesian bulls continue to sell very well to £172 for Messrs BD & RM Scambler and £155 for Messrs RG & VJ Griffin from Maxworthy, with no Friesian bulls sold under £42.

Heifer calves sold to a top of £250 twice for a Charolais x heifer sold by Messrs WJ Jose & Son and a British Blue x heifer selling for £250 for Messrs RG & VJ Griffin with many of the better heifer calves selling in excess of £200.

With only a handful of stirks on offer all being Holstein Friesian x bulls selling to a top of £310 for Messrs PR & EM Martin from Ashwater, with others at £250 to £255.

Quality of OTM's not so good as last week saw an overall average of 122p and £839. Best beef OTM's 180p (£1260) for a Limousin steer from Miss HM McCowan.

32 FINISHED CATTLE

Trade up 5 – 10p on last week with buyers again struggling to fill orders. Several second quality steers and heifers in demand, most over 170p top being 189.5p for a 660 kilo Limousin from Miss HM McCowan, Frithelstock which also realised the top price of £1247.40.

Top of the heifers this week was 184p for a handy weight 545 kilo Limousin from Messrs Middleton, Ashreigney. Many more lighter heifers could have been sold to a trade stronger than most deadweight centres. Several Friesian steers sold well from 160p – 164.5p for a 635 kilo Holstein from Messrs Colwill & Bellairs.
