A slightly smaller entry of sheep saw a tremendous trade throughout each section.

Draft ewes topped at £103 for Messrs D J Thomas and Son from Treguddick, with other around £97 for Messrs G E & M H Williams from St Kew and again for Mr Thomas.

A super turn out of prime hogs with a top price of £91.50 for heavy hogs sold by Mr P S Best from Cardinham, closely followed by Mr R M Quinn from Otterham with hogs at £90. Light hogs were lead by Messrs H L Banbury & Son from Wadebridge.

Top call of £84 for store hogs, for a pen from Mr R G Nankivell from St Breward, followed by pens from Mr R M Quinn and Mr B W Strout from Boyton at £81.

PRIME CATTLE & CULL COWS

Quality shone throughout at Hallworthy in the prime cattle section, with a super Charolais x steer realising 170ppk (£1394) for Mr J C P Old from St Minver with another steer at 164ppk.

In the overage and cull cow section, Mr Old had top price with a grand Limousin x cow at 136ppk, closely followed by Mr I C Gribble from North Hill with an Aberdeen Angus x cow at 135ppk making over £1000.

Out of parlour dairy cows met a very strong trade with Messrs J C Gynn & Sons from Warbstow fetching 125ppk and 120ppk for Friesian cows.

What a trade! Breeding cattle in short supply but with a huge demand. Best cows and calves from Messrs D & A Bolitho from Pensilva to £1140 for a 2005 born Hereford cow with her Charolais heifer calf at foot.

A superb run of in calf cows from Mr D Pascoe from Wendron realised £1210, £1180 and £1140 and his consignment averaged £1070 and we saw many potential purchasers going home empty handed.

Store cattle were a tremendous trade with a top of £1030 for a Blonde heifer from Messrs L J Gregory & Son from Coads Green. Hereford steers at 19 months old from Mr K J Routly of Marshgate hit £840, whilst Limousin and Blonde yearling steers from Mr F J Gribble made £705.

A full ringside and more cattle could have been sold to your advantage.

The round up sale of suckled calves continued to realise the trade of the Autumn, with 6 month old steers from Mr D Osborne selling to £610, with an average of £573. Charolais heifers from Messrs D & A Bolitho at 6-7 months old hit £560 with an average of £557.50.
