Our Monthly Dairy Show and Sale saw a strong trade with a large number of buyers around the ring. Top price went to our Overall Champion and first prize heifer “Maymor Bluebell 18” a freshly calved heifer sired by Highland-H Stormin Norman selling to £2000 on behalf of Messrs TN Morrow and Partners, Truro. This

was closely followed by “Dodscott Matson Katie” a Matson daughter realising £1980 on behalf of Messrs DW and SE Turner of Torrington. Another heifer at the £1900 mark went to Messrs Colwill and Bellairs of Bude for their non-pedigree heifer.

A run of yearling/ heifer calves sold on behalf of Messrs BD and RM Scambler of the Supermoo herd sold to a super trade with June 2011 born heifers selling to £600 and November 2011 born heifers selling to £420.

The herd dispersal on behalf of Messrs WP and J Parnell of Grampound Road sold to a solid trade for non-recorded and non-pedigree cows which topped at £1350 for an in milk cow, dry cows sold to £1100 and two in calf heifers due May sold to £1200.

30 CULL COWS

An exceptional entry of Holstein Friesian cows achieved an overall section average of £836.55 and a top price of £1090.05 (129ppk) for Messrs C P Button Ltd from St Tudy, others from the same vendor to £1049.20.
