**104 CALVES & STIRKS**

A good entry of quality calves to start the year off, with both vendors and purchasers travelling to Holsworthy from throughout the region.

Trade has started off very keen with many vendors receiving premium prices. Top price for bulls went to a superb British Blue X selling for £382 on behalf of Messrs JR & MJ Ovens from Beaworthy, closely followed by another British Blue X bull selling for £366 on behalf of Messrs AJ & JJ Tucker from

Langtree, and a further two British Blue bulls selling for £350 for Messrs RC & TA Mitchell from Clawton. All British Blue X bulls on offer averaging £295.56, to include some very young bulls from Messrs J Colgrove & Partners from Mevagissey making between £220 to £320.

Limousin bulls sold to a top of £375 for Messrs RG, LA & SR Wearing from Tavistock with another two Limousin bulls selling for £360 for Mr WD Medland from Whitstone, and Mr WS Bond from West Putford, with several others making in excess of £350. A young Simmental X bull calf selling for £338 for Mrs P Marsh from St Clether, and the 23 Friesian bulls on offer averaging £115.70, selling to a top of £240 times two, one for Mr GRM Hill from Lamerton and another for KD Ellis from North Petherwin.

Heifer calves also sold to a strong trade with a bunch of three strong Hereford X heifers selling for £405 for Mr GRM Hill with younger heifers selling to £305 for a British Blue X being sold by Mrs P Marsh from St Clether, with another from the same vendor selling for £300 with Limousin heifers selling to £300 from Mr WD Medland from Whitstone and Charolais X heifers to £310 for Mr KD Ellis from North Petherwin.

As in previous weeks several buyers going home empty handed or not able to fill their orders, many more calves could easily be sold to take advantage of this strong trade.

*The winners of this week's Genus prizes of £25 semen vouchers for the highest priced calves sired by a Genus bull were Mr J Ovens, Brendon, Halwill, Beaworthy with a British Blue sired using Fertility Plus realising £382. The heifer section was won jointly by Mr J Buckpitt, Moorview, Milton Damerel with a Limousin sired by Chytodden Conan and Mr P Henwood, Ponderosa, St Issey, Wadebridge with a Simmental sired by Beeches Nashville both making £200.*

## 15 OTM CATTLE

A short entry of varied quality saw best beef cows to 125.5p (£1057.80) for a Charolais from Rob Bray of Helscott. Best OTM Holsteins to 122p (£945.50). Several plainer leaner OTM's at 85.92p. Average Holsteins 100p.

*This week's winners of the Briarwoods Ltd Awards goes to Mr WF Bray, East Helscott Farm, Bude, for a Charolais Cow OTM realising £1057.80, and for the fats a steer submitted by Mr S Hopper, Rydon Farm, Holsworthy, for a Limousin making £1300.*

## 30 FINISHED CATTLE

Several Friesian steers and heifers saw the overall average back on previous weeks but still a very strong selling trade with Continentals topping at 191p for a handy weight Limousin from Mr Stan Hopper, Rydon which realised £1300, whilst few heifers topped at 160p for a light weight British Blue from Mr David Hopper. Several Friesian steers without finish sold well with 23 month Holsteins to 153p. More cattle required early January as buyers are struggling to fill orders.
