Top call of the day was £1500 given for the pick of a useful consignment in from Wayland Farm near Liskeard with the best of the part dispersal from Quarrystone Stud of Kingsbirdge hitting £1380 for 'Foxy' a 15hh six year old bay mare.

Amongst the young stock Miss K Skelly of Plymouth topped the day at £400 for a 16 month old gelding with several between £300 - £370. Within the smaller riding ponies and horses Miss K May of Liskeard sold a smart four year old at £740 with Sue Langley of Yelverton not far behind at £440.

The largest entry of tack of the year saw spirited bidding throughout, the best being £72 given for a 'set of harnesses' as part of a dispersal from the South East with several saddles between £40 - £68 with everyone going home happy.
