KIVELLS OF LISKEARD SAW A SEASONAL ENTRY OF CATTLE AND SHEEP.



STORE, PRIME & OTM CATTLE – AUCTIONEER PATRICK DENNIS 07831 620990

A top call of £968 for the pick of the store cattle on behalf of Messrs JP Matthews & Son of Torpoint with others from the same good farm at £890 for a trio of 18 month South Devon heifers. Several young cattle between £855 - £875 together with Mr Hoskins of Saltash hitting £925 for the pick of his run of 11. The overall average of the day stood at an immense £782 with many more needed.

Just a handful of cull cows on offer with premium set at 113.5p/kg and £806 on behalf of Messrs Tamblyns of Wotton, Landrake. Numbers were better in the calf pens with a top call of £290 for the pick of a good run of Limousins from Messrs Jones & Son of Landrake with others at £275, £265 and £255, with their entire entry averaging over the £250 barrier. Messrs White & Partners of Looe were in pole position in the heifer pens at £185 for the best of their run of young heifer calves.

SHEEP – AUCTIONEER STEVE PROUSE 07767 895366

A disappointing entry of cull ewes saw the best at £86.50 for Mr GP Hoddinott of Redmoor with Mark Tamblyn at £78.50 and Mr Hill at £74. Overall average for the cull ewes stood at £81. In the lamb pens a top call of £90 was seen for the best of Mr Couch lambs from Cuttapitt with Messrs Eastleigh of Looe at £84 and Messrs Willis at £83.80 premium was set at 197.2p/kg by Messrs Champion of Duloe with an overall average of 187.94p/kg. In the store lamb pens Messrs Woollett of Port Looe took the top call at £78.50 with others at £76.50 and Messrs Goddard at £75.50.
