Prime Cattle to 384ppk and £2797 Cull Cows to 366ppk and £2865

The lack of numbers forward was certainly more than made up by the returns achieved in the cattle pens on Monday when we saw some outstanding bred and turned-out prime and cull cattle come back at some very impressive figures. Finished steers topped out at 384ppk for a super 638kg British Blonde bullock from Adrian and Bradley Bowden, Drewsteignton which also grossed them £2445. Highest total money realised in the prime cattle section was a whopping £2797 (844kg x 332ppk) given for a giant of a South Devon steer from Steve Harris of Littlehempston who saw others with similar comments rise to £2745 (768kg x 359ppk). Very decent South Devon crossbred steers sold on behalf of Rob Corkery in from Higher Metcombe peaked at £2413 (664kg x 364ppk) whilst the better of his heifers of the same breed sold to \pounds 1937 (574kg x 338ppk). Over thirty month prime saw a neat Devon steer (35m) reach £1725 (600kg x 288ppk) for Chris and Naomi Hammett in from Colyford. Some exceptional cull cows on offer this week, not least in the form of an extraordinary suckler bred British Blue cross from Mark Davis of Burlescombe which was just about as well covered as you will find a barrener to be. She weighed in at a mighty 784kg and at an impressive 366ppk came back at a new centre record for a cull cow of £2865. Plenty of other top notch beef bred cow prices to report including South Devons to a creditable £2342 (832kg x 282ppk) for David Heath of Sherford and Limousins realising £2241(788kg x 285ppk) for Peter Hooper of Bovey Tracey. Also, a splendid British Blonde from Adrian and Bradley Bowden drew a considerable £2157 (686kg x 315ppk) followed by a smart Aberdeen Angus cow off the same farm which levelled out at £1844 (660kg x 280ppk). Charolais sold readily and to £2104 (732kg x 288ppk) and £2058 (716kg x 288ppk) for Richard Player, Thorverton and LG Pincombe of Mariansleigh respectively whilst dairy bred British Blue cows ran to £2010 (760kg x 265ppk) for Peter Hooper and a stout Devon bred barrener from Phillip Trump in from Luton, Chudleigh reached £1816 (674kg x 270ppk)

Spring Lambs to £200 & 438ppk Prime Hoggs to £189 & 346ppk Cull Ewes to £400 & Rams to £275

Busy busy in the sheep pens today with 5377 head forward and sold from 211 different vendors from across the Westcountry and up the south coast selling to no less than 17 individuals representing all major firms throughout the country and a total of 82 different accounts. There really is tremendous demand and plenty of buying power here at Exeter.

1449 PRIME SPRING LAMBS

1449 prime spring lambs and trade just a touch firmer as we approach Easter but unfortunately not the dizzy heights we saw a fortnight ago or this time last year. A few choice heavies catching the eye of butchers and selling to tops of £200 for Jack Enticott and family of Wellington with a single as a whole pen from this good farm also rose to £190, closely followed by Michael Down of Payhembury at £188, Ross May and family of Netherexe with a large pen of overweights at £187, Ben & Amelia Watts of Ashburton at £183 and Tom Yandle of Exton with the best of his overweights at £180. 52's to £188 again for Ross May and family as 50's reached £186 for Ben & Sara Tuck and family of Honiton and a smart pen of 49's sailed to £188 and 384ppk for Rodney & Fiona Thorne, trading as Mountberry Farm of Taunton. The 44's to 48's are the hardest sell at the moment being too heavy for export and not heavy enough for wholesale trade ahead of Easter, but that said 46's sold to \pounds 176 for Robert & Edward Mortimer of Kennford, 45's to £179.50 for West Upham Farm of Cheriton Fitzpaine and £176.50 again for Ben & Sara Tuck as 44's peaked at £177.50 again for Michael Down. Best of the 43's to £178.50 for Diane & Rob Dyer of Yarcombe and £177.50 for Ben and Amelia Watts as 42's reached £175 for tremendous Charollais cross sorts from Jack & Will Luckes of Totnes trading as A & L Farming who also topped the 40kgs when their pen made £172 and 430ppk. Lightweight lambs still in good demand and this weight range gave the top pence per kilo of 438ppk twice, firstly for Adrian Pike and family of Crediton with 36's at £157.50 but also for Chris

Rowdon of Dartmouth with his 39's at £171 as well as more handyweight lambs from Chris being 39's at £169.50 and 38's at £166.50 & £164. Other 39's at £168 for Geoff & Liz Hosegood of Crediton and the heandyweights this week averaged 418ppk with an improved SQQ of 400ppk and overall average of 383ppk and £166.42 per head.

2337 PRIME HOGGS & 43 MATURE SHEEP

2337 prime hoggs and 43 mature sheep were a better trade than expected with handyweights very similar, the 48 to 54kg hoggs possibly not as good as last week, but the heavier end of the hoggs certainly more lively today with what looks like the cull ewe trade lifting these hoggs. Dave Chapple of Cadeleigh topped the sale at £189 with Robert & Richard Rowe and families of Bridgwater selling their best at £187, £183.50 and £182 twice as Sue Veysey of Cullompton reached £186, both Darren Reed of Broadwoodkelly and Jon & Helen Putt of Tedburn St Mary reached £183 and David Churchill of Axminster also made £182. 51's and 52's to £154 for Jim Summerhayes of Upottery late in the day and £153 for Phil & Richard Coaker of Postbridge as some choice 48kg hoggs rose to £160 for Phillip Hopkins of Honiton and £155 for Phil Lee of Tedburn St Mary whilst a smart pen of 47's also late in the day rose to £151.50 for David & Maurice Wonnacott of South Zeal who also sold smart 45's at £147. Plenty of handyweight hoggs on offer and these meeting good demand with yet more fresh faces in the alleys for these. 41's from Matthew Petherick and family of North Petherwin rose to £138.50 as well as his 39's at £128, 38's at £125.50 & £122, 37's at £121 and 36's at £119. Other 39's to £135 and a sale topping 346ppk for Blue Texel's from Tom Woollacott and family of Smeatharpe.

With ewe trade as crazy as it is the heavy mature sheep took a certain lift too, these topping at £188 for Duncan Kittow of Tiverton, £182 & £176 for the Rowe family, £170 for Adam Pitts of Exminster and the best per kilo going to Martin and Adam Crabb of Luppitt with 55kgs at 300p and £165 per head.

A tremendously busy day in the sheep pens and my heart felt thanks to all vendors for their patience and support, thanks to those who helped sort and move sheep. Big thanks to the team, many of whom started 6am this morning and weighed the last of the hoggs at 3.15 this afternoon.

637 CULL EWES & 21 RAMS

A record breaking day here today in the cull ewes pens with all classes as dear as anyone has ever seen them leaving us with an unprecedented average of £182.84, nearly 183 guid. Absolutely fantastic! Top prices smashed twice here today with Sue Summerhayes representing FH Chave & Son of Wellington selling a pen of 7 tremendous Texel ewes at £375 smashing the record by the tenner before exhibiting a superb single that rang the bell at £400. The Chaves had others at £350 and £280 twice whilst the Quick family of Crediton had a single Texel at £380, Jack Enticott with similar at £350 and Bernard Strout, up from Launceston with a Texel at £320. Best of the Charollais also at £320, this time for Ben and Amelia Watts as John Simons of South Chard was the last pen to be sold at 5.45 this evening and had Charollais at £298 & £292, Duncan Kittow with Texel's at £298 and more of the same at £288 for Adrian & Julie Rich and and £285 for Mark Moore of Whitestone, Holsworthy. Too many to mention £250 to 3280 with the best of the pure Suffolk's at £268 for the Derryman family of Yarcombe, Suffolk cross Mules to £252 for Tom Yandle of Exton and a seriously heavy Dorset rose to £252 for Jerry Brook of Crediton. Suffolk Mules often £210 to £240 if big and heavy with a cut below often £180 to £210. Mules regularly £170 to £185 for large penfuls with Milborne Wick Farms of Sherborne surely setting a new record with a single Mule at £215. Horned ewes present in dribs and drabs with any meat usually £110 to £135 with leaner and lighter ewes either side of £100 and only the very plain of anything less than £80.

Rams still flying high too with John Howard of Crediton reaching £275 with a lean but heavy Suffolk, Derek Arnold of Morchard Road with Berrichon's at £245 & £228, Beranrd Strout also at £228 with a Suffolk and Adam Pitts made £223 of his.

Thanks again to everyone for your support and patience in what was a memorable day in the cull ewe pens.

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
