Store Steers to £3000 Store Heifers to £2900

An excellent entry of store cattle here at Exeter this week with a phenomenal trade for all on offer and some exceptional returns seen including centre record breaking highs for both store steers and heifers. Steers topped out at an amazing new market record of £3000 given for a big powerful Charolais (19m) from Barry Mildon and Family in from Cadbury who also saw a smart trio of Charolais bullocks reach £2800 apiece whilst later born sorts (14m) from John Cole and Family of lyybridge still ran to £2080. John and Emily Northam brought a tremendous run of cattle down from Wellington and parted with a super pen of four red Limousin steers (23m) for £2800 a head followed by Aberdeen Angus £21m) at £2660 for Roger, Jill and Giles ford down from Knowle, Crediton together with other native breeds also making £2660 for a pair of strong Herefords from Trevor and Sue Crocker from Diptford. A lovely run of cattle from Richard Kent down from Reigate, Surrey was headed by his Simmental steers (22m) which eased to £2630 followed by his later born yearling Simmental bullocks selling to an impressive £2480. South Devon steers selling to a premium once again this week when rising to £2600 (27m) for one from HTP Martin of Kingsbridge followed by a trio (25m) drawing £2390 for Matt Dyer from Trusham and a pair of younger (16m) sorts from Phillip and Richard Coaker in from Postbridge which hit £2320 apiece. British Blue steers in great demand again this week with a top of £2290 for a grand single (27m) from Phillip Slade of Calverleigh with younger (18m) types still making £2280 for John Cole and Family who also parted with a smart Salers bullock (22m) for £2120. As with the store steers, records were broken in the heifer pens when an incredible Parthenaise (24m) from Rob and Sharon Luscombe of Avonwick climbed up to the dizzy heights of £2900 whilst their second best with similar comments drew £2680. John and Emily Northam were back when selling more very smart Red Limousins, this time seeing bunches of heifers (23m) go for £2660 and £2540 whilst younger types (16m) from Phillip and Tom Cleave of Holne reached a creditable £1880 and dairy bred sorts (also 16m) ran to £1760 for a neat pen of ten from David Burrough and Family of Chardstock. HTP Martin returned to part with glorious South Devon females (25m) for £2460 whilst Simon Booty in from Poundsgate saw similar aged South Devon females for £2400 and Phillip and Richard Coaker saw a pen of eight striking sorts (20m) rise to £1710 a life. Charolais heifers (23m) up next and selling to £2070 for Bruce Ellett from Exmouth and to £1850 for younger (16m) ones from Phillip and Tom Cleave with Aberdeen Angus (22m) at £2010 for Richard Kent who also saw later born Simmental heifers (13m) sell readily at £2140. Better of the many British Blue females on offer (25m) ran to £1980 for a smart trio from John and Emily Northam followed by another good three heifers from Trevor and Sue Crocker with Herefords (26m) to £1970.

Best of the young dairy bred types saw Malcolm Harris of Slapton sell Limousin cross steers (7m) which realised £1140, Andrew Barker of Dunsford presented Blues (7m) which attained £1080 whilst Julian Courtier & Family of Whiddon Down saw Blue steers (6m) which levelled out at £1050 & £960 with similar bred Angus types (6m) reaching £900. Tom Pollard led the way in the heifer section with South Devon heifers (12m) reaching £1400 with his second pen to £1320 and others (5m) levelling out at £1000. Ben Tristram & Family presented Charolais cross heifers (12m) which realised £1300 whilst Lottie Hill of Shepton Mallet presented British Shorthorn heifers (5m) which hit £1200. Useful Charolais heifers from A & V Tiernan attained £1140 whilst Jean & Terry Tall of Modbury saw their Angus heifers (12m) fly to £1080. Further native breeds this time from Melaine Forward of Talaton presented Hereford heifers (12m) which realised £1040 with further native breed firstly from LA Luxmoore seeing their Angus heifers (IIm) attaining £940, the same figure achieved for CM Hammett for similar goods. Young dairy bred types from Malcolm Harris saw Limousin heifers (8m) race to £880. Andrew Barker saw young Blue heifers (7m) attain £860 whilst Julian Courtier & Family saw pens of Blue heifers (5/6m) to £850 x2, £820 with Angus heifers (5m) to £800 & £790. Young, sweet Simmental heifers from Keith Wotton of Ditisham (3m) hit £770. A small showing of Bulls saw | Cornish & Sons of Holcombe Rogus level out at £1100 for Blues (13m).

Trevor & Mary Wilson of Kingsbridge sold a consignment of 50 head of British Friesian, non-recorded grazing type cows as the first consignment to disperse their herd to a top price of £3000 for a second calver with other fresh second and third calvers from the same farm at £2650 & £2600. The same vendors sold 30 Autumn calving cows all due in August & September to a roaring trade topping at £2900 twice with others to £2750, £2700, £2600, £2550 x 5 & £2500. Messrs Wilson's consignment of 50 averaged £2145.


