Monday saw prime cattle top at 410ppk given for a smart 550kg mediumweight South Devon steer from Adam Lidstone up from Kingsbridge which also realised £2252 whilst the same seller also parted with a heavyweight South Devon bullock for £2406 (604kg x 399ppk). Other heavies saw a strong Aberdeen Angus from B & S Parkinson of Umberleigh come back at £2806 (730kg x 385ppk) followed by the usual good offering from Adrian and Bradley Bowden, Drewsteignton who saw a couple of very decent British Blonde steers return £2604 (652kg x 400ppk) and £2534 (654kg x 388ppk). Better of the over thirty month prime came from Kathleen and Lewis Slade of Widecombe in the Moor and in the way of a stout Simmental heifer (36m) which grossed £2459 (712kg x 346ppk). B & S Parkinson also sold the top priced cull cow with their grand 742kg Aberdeen Angus reaching 278ppk and £2059 whilst grazing type cows ran to £1404 (640kg x 220ppk) for Graham Westaway in from Poughill with a Limousin and another Angus, this time from Frank Davies of Crediton which drew £1165 (584kg x 200ppk).

Also Ben Tuck and family of Honiton and John Quick and family of Coldridge sold 40kgs at straight £4 or £160 per head. 1405 prime hoggs and a massive show of 213 mature sheep were, like the lambs over so slightly better to sell. The highlight came late in the sale when Martin Crabb of Luppitt was given the day off by his son Adam to bring hoggs here to sell at Exeter and celebrate his big birthday! He had something to celebrate too when a single Texel bred hogg jumped to a massive £220 with others in pens from this good home attaining £187, £185 and £180 three times as John & Arthur Cuming of Moretonhamsptead sold two colossal hoggs at £191, a price matched by David Pratt and family of Huntsham with a massive single whilst they also had a trio at £185 and a smart pen of slightly lighter 54kg Texel bred hoggs claimed £171 and 317ppk for Richard Dare and family of Kilmington. Best of the 50-52kg hoggs to £172 and 337ppk for Dan Gould of Taunton and £166 for Jack Neale and family of Launceston with 49's at £155 for L Stephens of North Tawton and 48's to £153 for some of a great run from Micky Tylor, up from Helston. Ivor Pellow and family of Sourton with 45s reaching £147 followed by the same weight at £141 for Robert Nancekivell of Brendon, Somerset and £140 for Peter Farmer of Tipton St John. 44's to £138 for Lynnette Parkhouse and family of Pennymoor as 43's sailed to £137 for KH Allsopp and partners of Cadeleigh as PG Brown of east Worlington sold 42's at £135 and Tom Woollacott of Smeatharpe had shapely 40kg Blue Texel's at £132 and 330ppk. Other 40's at £127.50 for Richard Cole of South Molton as 39kg's reached £126 again for Robert Nancekivell and 36's made £118 for Ben Dennis of Inwardleigh and the top price per kilo of the day went to a plummy little 31kg hogg that made £109 and 352ppk for lan Braund of Whitestone. Toothers a straight price too with Richard Dare and family selling the last pen of old season on the day being 50kgs at £160 which was top price per kilo at 320ppk. Top price toothers per head went to Jonathan Mills of Totnes with a penful of 67kg Texel x 2T's at £182 followed by Tony Pickard at £173, Chris Walters of Launceston at £167 and Martin and Adam Crabb at £166.

1322 CULL EWES & 69 RAMS

A few more cull ewes than we anticipated as numbers come out across the country and although quality not quite as good as recent weeks, trade was also back in the region of £10 to £15 on last week's flyer but given the show of sheep on offer an overall average of £160 per head is no disaster. Best Texel ewes to £320 for Paul Quick and family of Crediton who also had a leaner Texel at £275 as well as a large pen of thick Charollais ewes at £275 as Richard Burrough and family of Axminster sold a pair of Texels at £290 whilst lan and Sue Tall of Modbury sold a Charollais at £278 and lan Braund of Whitestone had trio of Charollais at £274 as well as a Texel at £260. Ross May and family of Netherexe with the best of the crossbreds at £262 with the best of the rest often £240 to £254 and back around £10 on the week. Mules often in the £190's from several different vendors and hill ewes seeing Cheviots to £187 for Madddie Sizmur of Okehampton and Beulahs and Welsh often £130 to £135. Lots of leaner and plain lambing casualties coming forward now and almost outweighing demand with the better end £70 to £110 but plenty £40 to £68 and pulling that average back. Rams still a fiery trade with Roger and John Dennis of Tedburn St Mary topping the section at £268 with a single Texel as Mark & Henry Johnson and family of Bridport cleared out some old Dorset rams with five at £262 and another 5 at £230 with Graham Perkins and family at £248 and John & Emily Northam of Wellington with three at £230.


