Store Steers to £2520 Store Heifers to £2320

Nothing to complain about the store cattle trade again this week here at Exeter with bigger number forward selling to even stronger demand. Those still believing store cattle returns are on the slide should note when comparing prices to our corresponding sale at the start of August 2024 we have seen an uplift of over £500 for steers and £450 for heifers on the year! No shortage of buyers either, with those local bidders just as eager as any from further afield to secure cattle. Steers rose to a top of £2520 for a monstrous Charolais (22m) from Phil Keast and Family of North Tawton with their next offering with similar comments still rising to £2490 for a pair with another, a little younger (16m) reaching £2150 for Paul and Claire Hendy of Aveton Gifford and a cracker from Bruce Ellett of Exmouth making £2060. A standout Limousin Bullock sold on behalf of John Hallett in from Ottery st Mary eased to £2470 followed by later born (16m) Limousins at £2120 and £2060 for Paul and Claire Hendy and Crispin Harvey from Moretonhampstead respectively. John Hallett was back when selling a pair of well farmed Aberdeen Angus (25m) for £2410 apiece whilst further Angus from Sonia Hodgson of Hollacombe saw a super, solitary suckler sort realise £1950. Plenty of those grand British Blue steers about once again this Friday with the pick of them running to £2390 ahead for an eye catching trio (20m) from Steven Slade and Family of Aylesbeare followed by more solid looking Blues (23m) at £2290 for Phil Keast and Family and younger types (16m) making £2270 for Paul and Claire Hendy again. Some first rate Hereford bullocks forward as well this week with a top of £2350 gained for a pair (25m) from Trevor Stephens of Chittlehampton closely followed by a couple likewise sorts from Steve Snell of Chawleigh which were just a bid or two back at £2330 a life. British Blonde steers (26m) of some stature rose to £2240 for Phil Keast and Family and a very smart South Devon (only 15m) from John Jordan and Family of Gidleigh saw a creditable £1910. The store heifer section was headed by a glorious Limousin cross British Blue (just 14m) from Phillip and Dan Dennis of North Tawton which rose to £2320 with other whilst shapely British Blues (20m) came back at £2240 for Steven Slade and Family and grand Charolais (24m) from Phil Keast and Family returned £2200. Other Blues of note (24m) ran to £2120 and £2100 for John Searle in from Hollacombe who also parted with a trim Aberdeen Angus heifer (25m) for £2180. Bruce Ellett also sold tidy Angus females (26m) for £2000 as did Robert Moore up from Diptford who saw his (22m) draw £1980. Also, South Devon heifers sold readily and to £1850 for an aged sort (31m) from Fred Chanin of Thorverton whilst a much later born South Devons from Miles and Helen Partridge of Poundsgate saw a super trio of yearlings reach £1180 apiece.
