Store Steers to £2970 Store Heifers to £2460

Although no less money, after many weeks of a lifting trade store cattle prices did look to have levelled out somewhat here at Exeter this week. Having said that there were still some eye watering returns for all on offer with perhaps those younger suckler bred turning out sorts the trade of the morning again. Store steers reach a top of £2970 for a colossal British Blue (28m) from Andrew Poole in from Morchard Road who sold others of a similar age to £2860 and later born sorts (22m) for £2720. Further top notch Blue bullocks (24m) from David and Wendy Holland of Dolton also looked decent money with bunches selling to £2670 and £2540 followed by well grown younger Blues (18m) at £2200 for Edward Gay of Riddlecombe. Barry Mildon and Family were back for a second week and parting with more top quality Charolais bred steers (24m) and saw pairs rise to £2960 and £2780 whilst a grand Devon bred steer (26m) from MJ Comont & Son of Copplesstone drew a creditable £2560 and a solitary Simmental (24m) from David and Wendy Holland came back at £2520. Better of the Aberdeen Angus steers saw a massive one from ML Persey of Bradninch reach £2960 followed by a pen of four tidy sorts (21m) which eased to £2300 for Mike Cake of Rockbeare with a couple (24m) from Steven Slade and Family in from Aylesbeare not far back at £2260 apiece and younger (16m) Angus from Rob and Liz Buxton, Talaton reaching £1900. Steven Slade and Family also saw top priced South Devon and Hereford steers when selling for £2260 (24m) and £2140 (19m) respectfully with later born (15m) South Devon bullocks to £1970 for David Heath up from Sherford and super yearlings making £1650 for Steve Arrowsmith Brown of Postbridge. Some excellent consignments of Limousin bred steers forward this week with the very best rising to £2050 (16m) for Rob and Liz Buxton and a pair (24m) sold on behalf of Mike Biddick of Withiel drawing £2000. A good yarding of store heifers forward again this Friday here at Exeter with a top price of £2460 for a pair of nicely covered Aberdeen Angus (25m) from Robert and William Reddaway of South Tawton with others (19m) close at £2430 for AJ Withers & Sons of Cove and young Angus females (15m) drawing £1740 for Messrs Ayres and Nichols from High Bickington. A super run of South Devon heifers (25m) from Edward Foale of Coffinswell sold readily and to £2400, £2280 and £2010 whilst more good yearlings from Steve Arrowsmith Brown saw his best trio of South Devon heifers sell to a creditable £1510 a head. Steven Slade and Family were back when selling Limousin heifers (24m) to £2350 together with British Blues of a similar age for £2000 and a neat Devon female for £1940 whilst Lloyd Heywood down from Kentisbury saw a smart Hereford heifer (25m) reach £1800 and three high class British Blondes (16m) from Martin and Karen Curtis of Elburton ran to £1510 a life. Just a handful of grazing type cows about this week with a strong South Devon from Richard Quantick of Kingsteignton picking up £1840 and British Friesian sorts from LS Higgins & son Liskeard fetching to £1680.

Trade as ever remaining exceptional for all types. Tom Pollard for the second week running topped the section with South Devon steers (12m) attaining £1610 with younger types (9m) hitting £1180. Bruce Ellett of Exmouth presented a pair of Charolais cross steers (11m) which raced to £1490, closely followed by John & Sue Kittow of Silverton selling Beef Shorthorns (12m) realising £1480 with the second pen obtaining £1410. Rob Buxton of Talaton sold a superb run of dairy bred Blue steers (11m) with the best reaching £1460 with others to £1400. Roger White of Okehampton sold South Devon steers (11m) which realised £1450 whilst further native types from Brightley Farms of Umberleigh being Angus steers reaching £1430, the same figure achieved for IG Mortimore & Son of Chagford selling Charolais cross steers (12m). David & Justine Colton of Princetown saw the best of their young Angus steers (9m) attain £1380 with others to £1360. South Devon steers from Brittan & Co of South Brent topped out at £1280 (9m) with N Vincent of South Brent selling further South Devon steers to £1220. Best of the young dairy bred types saw Ben Watts of Plymouth sell Blue steers (7m) which hit £920 whilst Friesian steers selling well and topping out at £840 for WR & WA Woodley of Rattery (11m) with younger types (9m) hitting £700. Heifers topped out at £1425 for Bruce Ellett selling a pen of Charolais heifers (12m). Native types saw Tom Pollard hit £1380 for South Devon (13m) whilst Rob Buxton saw Limousin cross heifers (16m) reach £1330. Charolais heifers from IG Mortimore & Son hit £1290 (13m) whilst David & Justine Colton saw their Angus heifers (9m) realise £1270 with further Angus' this time from RG Bowditch Ltd of Payhembury attaining £1210 (9m). Well presented dairy Blue heifers from Rob Buxton (12m) realised £1190 whilst Michael Scott of Drewsteignton presented Blonde heifers (11m) which levelled out at £1160 with others to £970 & £940. Andrew Squire of Liverton presented Angus heifers (12m) which realised £1010 with South Devon types from Roger White of Okehampton levelling out at £1000 (11m). Young Blue dairy types from Ben Watts (7m) hit £880.

A good entry of calves saw a blistering hot trade from start to finish for all grades of calves!

Top of the day was £810 for a 8 week old South Devon bull from Richard Quantick of Newton Abbot. British Blue bulls were on fire topping at £750 for Stuart Dagworthy & Family of Woodbury Salterton with others to £688, £640 & £600 for Messrs RH & MJ Hurford of Axminster, £675 & £672 for Andrew, Rose & Mark Retter of Honiton, £670 for Roy & Katherine Emmett of South Molton and £570 for Roy Emmett of Cullompton. Charolais bulls were another level and were a serious trade topping at £580 & £550 for John Simmons of Poltimore and £565 & £555 for Messrs CS Colwill & Son of Buckfastleigh. Simmental bulls to £550 £490 for A Wotton of Dartmouth. Native bulls topped at £640 for a smart young Aberdeen Angus Bull from Messrs RH & MJ Hurford with others to £595 for Sam Ball & Ben Roberts of Exmouth, £590 for Messrs MJ & NM Shire of Woodbury Salterton and £572 for Michael Pyle of Broadhembury. Hereford bulls topped at £585, £530, £505 & £470 for Messrs BA Pyne & Son of Budleigh Salterton and £440 for Nigel, Brenda & Richard Tucker of Tiverton. Heifers topped at £570 for a British Blue heifer from Michael Pyle with other Blues to £455 for Roy & Katherine Emmett. Simmental heifers to £480 for A Wotton, Charolais heifers to £410 & £380 for John Simmons and Native calves saw young Aberdeen Angus heifers to £422 for Messrs MJ & NM Shire and Herefords to £440 x 2, £435 & £410 for Messrs BA Pyne & Son. 127 ORPHAN LAMBS & GOAT KIDS

A massive entry of 123 orphan lambs and 4 kid goats met a solid trade with tops of £62 for the best four, £58 of the next 11 and 46 of another three all from Michael Reddaway and family of Okehampton as Steve Bonner of Meshaw made £69 of his best and too many to mention selling either side of £40 with an overall average of £27 very much in line with recent weeks.

345 STORE HOGGS & NEW SEASON STORES

345 store hogs and a sprinkling of new season stores saw a great run from Katherine Starr of Dunkeswell sell to £145, £140 & £136 as well as toothers from the same home at £130. Phil Hutchings and family of Chagford reached £144, Michael Reddaway and family at £142 and both Steve Cleverdon of Hatherleigh and Dr Shelley of Shobrooke claimed £139 with plenty of other good short keep hogs then trading £125 to £138, a line up of good hill hogs trading from £104 to £115 and only the bottom end below £80 with an overall average of £105.24. A few consignments of new season stores rose to £143, £130 & £129 for Messrs Middleton of Ashreigny and to £139 for Lynher Valley Angus of Plymouth.

127 GRAZING EWES & RAMS

Grazers experienced the same resistance the cull ewes have generally over the past five days with prices still good but not the highs of the last month or so. Top money ewes at £176 for Matt Rogers Farming of Yealmpton who sold another pair at £150, a price matched by Matts late father David with a ram and also by Jim Winzer of Modbury. Lots of business done between £120 and £150 and they averaged £110 across a very mixed show.



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461 EWES/HOGGS & 613 LAMBS (1071 LIVES)

The highlight of the day was the couples with the first season sale of Hogg couples seeing nearly 200 outfits work into a decent trade ahead of expectations and last years results. Topping the hoggs and lambs were a smart pen of Texel x Mule hogg doubles at £410 whilst the singles of the same breed realised £335 all for Messrs Milborne Wick Farms of Sherborne who also sold Mule Hogg doubles at £340 and singles at £322 as well as Suffolk x Mules hogg singles at £332. Messrs Bone and Cole of Broadwoodwidge sold Mule hogg doubles at £320 as well as singles at £298, £290 & £280 with Gary & Helen Woodman of Chawleigh selling the same breed at £280 for twins and singles at £272 & £268 and both the Hutchings family of Launceston and Jon & Helen Putt of Tedburn St Mary sold Suffolk x singles at £280. Plenty of business for straight farming hogg singles done from £230 to £275.

The ewes and lambs started a straight price and just went dearer and dearer and dearer! Some quality on offer as well today, helping the averages which were set at £272 per outfit or a very pleasing £116 per life, especially when considering some of the bottom end sorts on offer too!

Top of the tree were two 6T aged Dorset Mule doubles with well grown lambs from Sam & Edward Ball & Ben Roberts of Exmouth sailing to £465 or £155 per life whilst their FM Suffolk x single peaked at £385 or £192.50 per life. More quality Charollais bred doubles from David Tucker of Sherford rose to £445 whilst his singles claimed £338, the very desirable breeding from Mark Moore of Whitestone saw his Aberfield doubles rise to £435 whilst singles of the same comments achieved £375 and older Texel doubles realised £382 off the same good farm. Trevor and Trish Bolt were pleased with their trip down from Huntsham with Dutch Spotted type doubles at £412 & £392 as Jock & Katherine Muirhead of Washford saw their best doubles sell at £410 & £402. Plenty of forward and good farming doubles over £300 with FM Mules to £358 for Mike Swerling of Mariansleigh and Colin Nankervis up from St Ives was left speechless when his Cheviot cross shearling double flew to £325! Plenty more singles either side of £280 and come the last third of the sale there was hardly a single under £100 per life.
