#### Store Steers to £2320 Store Heifers to £2150

Bigger numbers of store cattle here at Exeter this week which included our first 2025 Autumn show and sale of store cattle drawing some terrific runs of steers and heifers, although there were plenty of those much lower quality dairy crossbred types forward too on Friday. Demand again way ahead of the corresponding fixture last Autumn with another strong line up of purchasers from away and closer to home perhaps not quite so keen as we have seen them be, particularly for those harder done and lessor bred types. Store steers topped at a very creditable £2320 given for a trio of well turned out British Blues (25m) from Rosy Fishleigh of Sourton Cross with a further three Blues of high standard and of the same age reaching £2260 apiece for Simon Heywood of Bolham. Younger (17m) British Blue Bullocks from Richard and Rhys Widger up from Aveton Gifford eased to £1960 with the same duo also parting with a couple of standout Inra steers (18m) for £1930 each. Dave Reddaway of Widecombe in the Moor saw the better of his fine run of Charolais steers (20m) reach £2230 with eye catching slightly later born Charolais (16m) from Peter Hendy of Plymouth seeing his pen of four draw £1950 apiece. Several well bred and grown Limousin steers about this week, not least in the way of a cracker (26m) one from John and Helen Keep of Moretonhampstead which made £2190 followed by more decent Limousin sorts (19m) at £2030 for a pen of four from Keith Vincent up from Grampound. Ian Serpell of Plympton sent us a strong lineup of stores and saw grand Hereford steers (23m) make £2080 with further native breed bullocks (22m) coming back at £1940 for Ian Serpell again and £1940 once more for Keith Vincent with a younger pair (18m). Other good continental bred steers saw two British Blondes (24m) from Andrew Down of Barnstaple rise to £2060 a life whilst Rosy Fishleigh saw her super Simmental (25m) also realise £2060. Also, Friesian steers (28m) from Stephen Downing of Diptford sold to £1600 and well fed Devons (22m) ran to £1580 apiece for a pen of four from Brian Coward in from Bridestowe. A shapely red Limousin heifer (25m) from John and Helen Keep headed that section before going on to draw £2150 with others (23m) coming back at £1880 for a fine bunch of four from Simon Heywood who also parted with his better pen of British Blue heifers (23m) for £2100. Later born Blue females (15m) reached £1380 apiece for a trio from Steve Hallett of Sidbury. Some well summered South Devon bred South Devon heifers on show this week with the very best (26m) going for £2100 for a single from Roger Oliver of Lower Ashton followed by others (26m) at £1990 for Richard Baxter of Exwick and £1730 (22m) for Nick Isaac up from Ipplepen. Ian Serpell was back when selling classy Charolais heifers (22m) for £1840 and £1770 whilst an aged (41m) Simmental from Phillip Heard and Family of Okehampton picked up £1660 and a pair of decent Aberdeen Angus heifers (28m) from Stephen Downing were just a bid back at £1650.




