



Prime Cattle to 370ppk and £2282 Cull Cows to 290ppk and £2469

Monday saw prime cattle sell to a top per kilo of 370 pence given for a smart, rangy British Blue steer from David Slade of Chagford which at 606kg realised £2239, whilst further Blues bullocks from David came back at £2282 (628kg \times 364ppk). As ever, Adrian and Bradley Bowden brought a well fed and kept load of prime in from Drewsteignton and saw smart Hereford steers reach a decent £2207 (614kg \times 360ppk) and Limousin sell to £2106 (564kg \times 374ppk) together with their neat 564kg Devon bullock which levelled out at 330ppk and £1858. Best of the over thirty month prime cattle saw an aged (38m) British Blue heifer return £1807 (642kg \times 282ppk) for Maydown Farms of Bridport. Several well fleshed cull cows on offer this Monday with an immense Limousin from Rob and Sharon Luscombe up from South Brent topping that section at a considerable £2469 (868kg \times 285ppk). She was followed by a grand Beef Shorthorn barrener from Jack Foan of Cheriton Fitzpaine which drew £2053 (732kg \times 281ppk) and the better of a fine run of cows from Steve Francis from South Tawton who parted with another fine Limousin for £1962 (678kg \times 290ppk). Steve Francis also saw a shapely Aberdeen Angus cow rise to £1960 (682kg \times 288ppk) and a South Devon cross ease to £1798 (648kg \times 278ppk). Phillip Smith in from Luppitt came with lovely run of solid looking Devon cross cows and saw his top one reach an impressive £1681 (624kg \times 270ppk) whilst a trim British Blue grazing type cow from Nick Isaac if Ipplepen picked up £1218 (560kg \times 218ppk)

Spring lambs were dearer again, especially for the handyweights, whilst the heavies were just the same strong trade and a market average of 342ppk and £150.13 per head with an SQQ of 339ppk, up 9p on the week.

Six pens at or over £200 with a top of £204 given for a 76kg Suffolk ram lamb from David Bourne of North Tawton as Derek Arnold of Morchard Road sold an outstanding single Berrichon ram lamb at 61kgs for £202 as well as its 62kg crossbred pen mates at £200, other pure Suffolk ram lambs at £200 for Andy & Wendy Reed of Blackborough and all of the above going into the meat trade. Other good heavy crossbred lambs at £200 for Maisie O'Brien of Whimple and Rodney & Carol Cleave of Denbury whilst Messrs Milborne Wick Farms of Sherborne climbed to £199.50 and both Mick May of Copplestone and Sarah Kingdon of Tiverton had lambs at £198. Best per kilo in the overweights was 357ppk shared by Maisie O'Brien with her dad Andy selling 53's at £189 and all 88 overweights averaged within a few pence of £190.

52's to £181.50 for Pauline and Michael Scanes of Cheriton Bishop whilst their were five pens of 50kg lambs selling over £180 to tops of £184 & £181 for Andy Raines of Axbridge, £183.50 for Ross May and Family of Netherexe, £183 again for Andy O'Brien and £181 for Johnny Baker of Mark. 47's to £174.50 again for Andy O'Brien and 46's to £176 and a sale topping 383ppk for a tremendous single again from Andy Raines with the next best of this weight at £168 for Robin Irwin of Kings Nympton. And it was Robin Irwin who topped both the 45's and 44's with the best of these at £167.50 and £164 respectively as Rodney & Carol Cleave's 45's made £165.50 and their 44's were £160. 43's to £156.50

Amongst the lighter lambs 39's peaked at £135 for Adrian Bowden and Family of Drewsteignton followed by John Kittow of Exeter at £134, 38's to £129.50 for both David Crocombe of Muddiford and Mike Churchward of Kennford followed closely by Andrew Hendy of Diptford at £129 and the Chudley Family of Romansleigh at £138 who also sold 36's at £124. Chris & Katy Steer of Modbury with their 35's at £119.50 as well as 27kg lambs out of Welsh ewes at £90 which are included in the market averages.

129 PRIME HOGGS & 94 MATURE SHEEP

Still a fair number of hoggs for the first week in July with 223 old season on offer and the heavy meat continues to be the easiest sold. Overweight hoggs to £180 for Andrew & George Palk of Paignton, £174 & £166 for Martin & Adam Crabb of Luppitt, £170 for Johnny Baker, £169 for Paul Vanstone of Bratton Clovelly and £166 for Keith Raymond of Salisbury. Best heavies almost £3 per kilo with Martin & Adam Crabb selling 52's at £154 as well as 51's at £149, a smart 45kg hogg sold at £129 again for Paul Vanstone whilst Johnny Baker topped the hoggs per kilo with his 41kg smart sort at £125 and 305ppk. Lighter and leaner hoggs of all weights harder to place with 38kg Herdwicks attaining 220ppk and £83.50 for Richard Hurdle of Chagford. Best of the toothers to £170 for both Paul Vanstone and Martin & Adam Crabb followed by Johnny Baker at £164.50 and Robert & Christine Steer at £156 with best per kilo of 276ppk going to Martin and Adam Crabb selling 50kgs at £138.

1086 CULL EWES & 28 RAMS

All but 1100 cull sheep is the largest offering we've seen since the Qurbani a month ago and trade just about as strong as it was back then! Texel ewes to £288 for a trio from Joanna Killin trading as Oxbridge Farm, Bridport, Keith Raymond smiling all the way home to Salisbury with his Charollais ewes at £267 and similar sorts at £235 for JMB Chadwick & Partners of Higher Ashton. The Wrixon Family of Wimborne exhibited a tremendous run of 194 cull ewes that saw 53 sell in excess of £200 to tops of £245, £235, £230 and £200 three times with the best of their mainly Berrichon cross ewes to average £185 of the whole consignment including some lean and approx. 50 Mules. Suffolk cross Mules to £214 for John Simmons of Poltimore with the general run of these £180 to £200 as heavy Mules from Tom Elliott of Winkleigh climbed to a colossal £196 and plenty of good Mules trading £150 to £170. Hill ewes peaked at £179 for Cheviots from Ben and Jess Collings of Launceston whilst fat Beulahs rose to £145 for Will Warren of South Brent. The general run of hill ewes selling £65 to £95 with some very plain and lighter sorts in the £40's and £50's and all included in the overall average of £142, up £16 on the week. Just a dozen rams and wethers and these still every bit as dear as recent weeks with BW Hearn of Wincanton topping the tree at £239 with a trio of Zwartbles rams, Johnny Baker with a pair of Charollais wethers at £228 and Jilly Handley of Sampford Courtenay with rams at £186 and £179 with the boys levelling at £179.


