DORSET MAY FAIR SALE

There was a real buzz in the air at this year's oldest established and most prominent sale for the Polled Dorset and Dorset Horn breed with vendors and breeders in high spirits throughout the showing on the Tuesday and a good crowd of mainly local buyers and onlookers for the sale on the Wednesday.

Wednesday's sale started with the individual pedigree females and the very first one in the ring was crowned Champion female in the pre-sale judging after winning the shearling ewe class for Rich and Alice Rossiter of the noted Huish flock, near Kingsbridge. This shearling was sired by Roci Elvis the King and sold at 1000gns back to the Roci flock of G & E Jones, Ceredigion. The reserve champion female came from the Sherborne flock of Rob and Richard Hole, Holwell, Sherborne and was the first prize winning ewe lamb Sherborne Hawthorne, sired by the noted Sandy Lane Capercaille she met frenzied bidding and sold at 1500gns to S Tayler of Shepton Mallet. Rob Harvey of Woodbridge, Suffolk sold Braiseworth Harlequin an October born ewe lamb by Richhill Gabriel that realised 850gns as Joe Larder of Sandford, Somerset sold a ewe lamb at 700gns and plenty of other business done between 400 and 650gns to give an average for the 26 individuals of £535.

The pens of pedigree and MV accredited females followed through the ring and although the quality was more varied than we are maybe used to at this fixture trade was strong throughout. Jack and Alexandria James of Shaftesbury claimed Champion pen of females with a strong pen of hoggett's that realised 300gns, whilst all Mark Hayman & Abi Dart of Bradninch, Caroline Bailey of Weymouth and Matt & Adam Care of Looe also made 300gns of their hoggetts. Some great annual consignments saw 49 from Fooks Bros of the Poorton flock near Bridport reach 320gns twice and 310gns three times to average £318 of their nine pens. Similarly Mark Thomas and family of Launceston exhibited 10 pens, five of which realised 300gns and their 74 hoggetts levelled at £306. Always a standout run from the Wilsey flock of Les and Heather French, near Launceston saw their first pen rise to 380gns with others at 340, 330 & 310gns to average £353 of 30 hoggets, up £28 on the year. Horned hoggetts sold to 350gns for Joe Larder and 320gns for Jasmine Jones of Gloucestershire with JH Kemball & Son of Woodbridge, Suffolk selling both horned shearlings and horned ewes at 290gns. Horned ewes peaked at 310gns again for Jasmine Jones as Nigel Wernham of Newbury, Berkshire sold his five horned ewes at 300gns and Jasmine Jones topped the older ewes with a single halter trained 3yr old polled ewe at 340gns. Ewe lambs saw the first prize winning pen of five who were also awarded reserve champions come from the Sherborne flock and sell at 300gns closely followed by Joe Larder at 290gns who also sold a pair of horned ewe lambs at 350gns. The 344 sheep in this section sold from 115 to 380gns to average £302 overall.

There were a similar number of non MV accredited sheep to the previous few years with 877 forward and although there was much speculation prior to the sale of how the trade would be, I think all vendors were pleasantly surprised to see averages up on last year. On a day where numbers were short and the sheep just got dearer and dearer the top of the trade came for the last lot of purebred hoggetts from Charlotte Radley of Tiverton whose three strong pens sold at £320, £315 & £300. Other strong hoggetts at £300 twice for Derek & Martin Cole of Bradninch who sold 73 to average £280, MJ & DM Lake of South Molton sold all five of their pens at £295, Alan Bickley of Puddington also reached £295 and averaged £292 with other good runs of purebred hoggs at £285 and averaging £260 for David & Adrian Cole of Bradninch and also £285 averaging £251 for Ivor Prouse and family of Holsworthy.


A genuine run of registered older ewes from David Barnett Farms down from Northamptonshire met with great interest and saw the pick of his one crop ewes reach £315 with others at £295 twice and £285 whilst his two crop ewes made £270. Messrs S & D Cole of Torrington sold their annual consignment of registered hoggs to tops of £285 twice and £260 twice as well as registered ewe lambs at £210.

Purebred ewe lambs reached £210 for both pens from Alan Bickley and Mervyn Brice of Stoodleigh sold Berrichon x Dorset shearlings well at £295 (x3) and £290 twice to average £293 of 50 sold and a few sale day entries of Dorset x Mule hoggs saw Michael & David Snell of Knowstone claim £200 for their first four pens.

131 POLLED DORSET & DORSET HORN RAMS & RAM LAMBS

With a few less rams catalogued this year and more pedigree and commercial buyers ringside the ram trade had a much better feel to it than last year and a nearly 90% clearance rate was achieved with an overall average of £906 for the 117 sold.

Topping the day was the pre-sale champion, Richhill Hakka, an Oliver Tree George sired lamb from the Northern Irish, Richhill flock of Ben Lamb, County Armagh, that after much bidding from all sides of the ring and all nations of Great Britain sold to TV Hughes & Co of Carmerthenshire, South Wales for 4500gns. The reserve champion Burhos Giant, was as the name suggests and a well grown powerful shearling from Cornish breeders Matt & Adam Care from their Burhos flock based in Looe, sired by the Islaharnan Fernando sire he heads home with Jim & Joe Dufosee to join their Blackhill flock near Warminster, Wiltshire for 3600gns. The Care brothers reinvested £3000 of their sale proceeds in Maineview Huntsman, a Sherborne Falcon sired ram lamb from the Ballymena home of Andrew & Caroline Kennedy, Northern Ireland. Also at 3000gns was the pick of the Horned exhibits, being Poorton Gabriel, a Poorton Double Diamond sired shearling from Fooks Bros of Bridport, it sold to Ben May and family of Netherexe, near Exeter. Julian Rice of North Tawton, Devon sold his best lamb at 2200gns closely followed by Joe Larder of Sandford, Somerset at 2000gns with Laura Weir across from County Antrim selling her best at 1800gns and both the Huish flock and Sherborne flock selling ram lambs at 1700gns.



Store Steers to £2650 Store Heifers to £2770

A decent number of store cattle forward this week with over 400 head penned and sold and although we perhaps are now not seeing these store selling to the dizzy heights they were a month ago Fridays trade looked well in line with a good percentage of them leaving the South West again. A matching pair of strong, forward Limousin and Charolais steers (24m) from Hubert Chugg in from Stockleigh Pomeroy headed that section when drawing £2650 apiece followed by further smart, hefty Charolais bullocks (22m) at £2640 and £2600 for Richard Brayley of Jacobstowe and Barry Mildon and Family, Cadbury respectively. An eye catching yearling Charolais steer from Sandy Harvey from Broadwoodwidger look well sold when fetching £1900. Andrew & Phillip Cook from Widworthy, Honiton brought a tremendous run of 17 month stores and saw pairs of South Devon and Aberdeen Angus steers reach £2580 and £2480 with other South Devons (25m) reached £2380 for Ion Vincent up from Plymouth and more Angus (24m) with good cover from Russell Retter and Family of Cotleigh selling for £2370 apiece for a pen of four, also, later born South Devons (13m) saw another bunch of four ease to £1950 a life for David and Mark Risdon of Broadwoodkelly. John and Emily Northam, Wellington brought another load of their well bred and fed stores on Friday and parted with a couple of lots of outstanding Limousin steers (24m) for £2500 each with the better of the younger (16m) types of the same breed still making £2020 for William Bromell of Chagford. Several of those grand British Blue bullocks about as usual this week with the very best (21m) selling to £2390 for Andrew and Phillip Cooke and £2300 (20m) for David and Wendy Holland, Dolton whilst a well farmed single Blue (25m) from Robert Harvey and Family of Plymouth rose to a creditable £2270. Ian Widdicombe up from Berry Pomeroy saw the best of his lovely run of shiny coated Stabiliser steers (20m) rise to £2220 whilst Hereford bullocks (25m) saw £2000 for Ford and Watts of Ashwater and younger Herefords (16m) sold readily at £1900 for David Skelley of Shaugh Prior. Richard Brayley was back when selling another tremendous Charolais and making a £2770 of his heifer (25m) as was Barry Mildon and Family with theirs (23m) at £2680 and Sandy Harvey selling young Charolais females (13m) for £2020. Also returning was John and Emily Northam who saw a trio of smart Limousin heifers £25m) come back at £2600 each whilst the same duo sold a pen of three good Aberdeen Angus females (25m) for £2160 a life. Hereford heifers (20m) from RWG Warren in from Way Village drew an impressive £2140 with British Blues (18m) also looking well sold at £1990 for Andrew & Phillip Cooke together with Friesian heifers (27m) at £1900 for Robert Shilston and Gemma Houghton from Bovey Tracey. Super Stabiliser heifers (20m) from Ian Widdicombe sold to £1880 followed by Devons (28m) from Andrew Phillips of Manaton at £1840 and young (14m) South Devon females at £1780 for David and Mark Risdon. Mike Biddick sold a decent South Devon cow with her young calf beside her for £2350 whilst the best of the grazing cows went to £1920, again for a South Devon from Phillip and Richard Coaker of Postbridge.

A lesser show in terms of quality yet trade firing on all cylinders with RJ & D Thomson of Pennymoor presenting sweet Angus steers (11m) topping the sale at £1540. Roger Hunt of Stoke Gabriel levelled out at £1400 for further Angus steers (12m) whilst Limousins off the same good farm attained £1300 (12m). The Hampton Family of Lustleigh saw Hereford cross steers (10m) realise £1240 whilst a superb run of dairy bred Angus and Blue stirks from J & J Webber of Chulmleigh saw Angus steers (9m) hit £1190 with younger types to £1120 and further pens levelling out at £1100 whilst best of the Blue steers (7m) topped out at £1035 with others of a similar age to £1000. IG Mortimore & Son of Chagford presented Charolais cross steers (11m) which realised £1140 with South Devon steers out of the same stable to £920. Young Blue stirks from the Courtier Family of Whiddon Down topped out at £880 (7m). Best of the Friesian steers saw RF James of Ashbuton level out at £900 (12m) whilst a useful pen from J & J Webber (9m) hit £860. No real strength in the heifer section but the best topped out at £1180 for RJ & D Thomson again presenting Angus types with Charolais' from IG Mortimore & Son hitting £1110. Roger Hunt saw Angus heifers realise £1030 with young South Devon heifers from Brittan & Co of South Brent hitting £1020. Dairy bred types from J & J Webber saw Angus heifers (9m) realise £1010 with Blues (7m) attaining £965 with further Angus heifers (8m) levelling out at £930. Young Blue heifers from the Courtier Family attained £830 (7m).

Good number of calves forward in Exeter on Friday, where we saw a mix bag in regard to quality with plenty of strong continentals and then some smaller native sorts. All types and grades of calves selling to a wonderful trade, with very little sold under £200 with some 3rd quality types looking very well sold trading between £200-£300 and the better end trading between £500-£700. One of the last calves of the day sold by JW & LF Baker, Exeter rocketed up to a mega £692 for an outstanding, showy Blue bull, with more from the same good stable at £600 only being young and fresh. Further Blue bulls selling well at £685 for RH & MJ Hurford, Axminster, £610 for |R & SR Dagworthy with younger sorts to £545 for A| & |A Lock, Plymtree and £465 presented by GS Emmett. An eye catching Limousin bull raced up to £600 for Paul Hendy travelling up from the South Devon coast, other Limousins to £560 for IC Pincombe of Crediton and £505 for G Kittow down from Cullompton. A strong run of Angus bulls sold well and reached £575 for a lovely bull in from HI Baldwin and Sons of Meshaw, others to £562, £530, £520, and £515 for a wonderful run in from MJ & AJ Saunders, Hemyock. A large entry of Herefords penned and reached £540, £532, £515 x2, and £500 for a grand run of bulls all in from BA Pyne and Son of Budleigh Salterton. Other strong Hereford bulls made £500 for the Vallis Family down from Bradninch. Well reared but slightly older Blue heifers topped out at a grand £700 for a smart Blue in from HJ Baldwin, other well put together Blue heifers to £580 JR & SR Dagworthy and £568 GS Emmett with plenty of other strong heifers over £500 with all 16 averaging an impressive £446! A sweet, well-muscled Charolais heifer soared up to £610 for Paul Hendy again followed by a pair of red reared Hereford heifers at £600 for | Cornish and Sons of Westleigh and plenty of other younger Hereford heifers selling well between £320-£400. A sweet young Limousin heifer made £435 for C| Lee of Nadderwater, and the best of the Angus heifers saw plenty of demand and made £460 J Cornish, and a smart run earning £420, £405 and £360 for MJ and AJ Saunders again. A bunch of x4 proper Friesian bulls produced strong returns and £230 in from IC Pincombe, further Friesian bulls to £195 for both HJ Baldwin and for RA & SA Reed of Kentisbeare with all Friesians averaging £158.

250 STORE HOGGS & 22 NEW SEASON LAMBS

A typical early May entry of store hoggs and lambs met with very strong demand for the time of year, considering the current sheep climate and the quality forward. Hoggs to £139 & £125 for Peter Tucker of High Bickington, £137 for S Burch of Merrymeet, £134 for Colin Gibbins of Feniton, £133 for RWT Southwood of Broadhempston and £130 twice for the Jordan family of Chagford. New season lambs sold to £128 for Dan & Helen Partridge of Dunsford and although the average was just over £90 apiece, that is more reflective of the quality rather than the trade.

95 GRAZING EWES & 4 GOATS

The grazers and goats followed the trend of the fiery hogg trade with ewes perhaps a shade firmer on the week. Joe Beare of Ashwater topping it with a pair of Texel and Charollais type ewes at £194, Tom Dawe of Lifton had a Charollais type at £190 and Ann Brown of Ottery St Mary sold a pen of Dorset's well at £152 with John Kittow of Broadclyst at £149 and £129 and plenty of other odd pens or lots selling £120 to £140 to leave an average of £109 overall with the four goats from David Stephens of Liskeard selling to £76.

248 EWES/HOGGS & 313 LAMBS (561 LIVES)

A much reduced entry of couples sold to a reduced crowd of buyers, with trade back to reality after last week's orbital display. A tremendous Texel single took top honours today, selling at £372 or £186 per life for Archie Hill of Shepton Mallet as Martin Partridge of Christow sold four Zwartbles FM doubles at £362 or £121 per life. Emily Pearse of Colebrook sold a Mule double at £335 as well as a pen of strong Mule singles at £288, followed by the Fone family of Upottery with a double at £328 and Ray Tucker of Bridford with a double at £305 as well as a pen of nice farming Dorset FM singles which flew to £305. Nice farming doubles generally either side of £300 with a fe more singles touching it too with Archie Hill selling Beltex singles at £295 and the Fone family with a shearling single at £290. Hoggs couples this week peaking at £280 four times, firstly for two pens of Mule hogg doubles from Gary & Helen Woodman of Chawleigh who sold Mule singles at £252 & £250. Also at £280 were a pen of Cheviot Mule hogg singles from Peter Tucker of Cadeleigh who also sold a single black hogg of the same breed at £280 and pen of slightly smaller Cheviot Mule hogg singles at £265 as well as NC Mule singles at £260 & £252. Derek & Martin Cole of Bradninch sold a Suffolk x single at £270 and the Fone family made £268 of their Suffolk x Mule hogg singles. Hill ewes saw Scotch F/BM doubles sell to £200 & £180 for the Medland family of Tavistock whilst their singles were £138 & £128 and smaller Jacobs at £110 and Shetlands £105 for various vendors but all included in the average of £103 per life or £233 per family.


