More store cattle now coming forward as we enter those generally busier autumn months and as reported over the last couple of weeks demand for any of those well summered sorts of all grades looking as strong as ever whilst any poorer bred and kept types which were left to fend for themselves during that dry period are now looking less desirable. Steers topped at an admirable £2450 given for a giant of a South Devon (27m) from Chris Lentern in from Chagford followed by several more excellent South Devons, Including four eye catching sorts (18m) from Gerald and Jill Vallance of Ashburton selling to £2100 apiece and another pen of four smart ones (20m) making £1990 a life for David Smith and Family up from Littlehempston. Grand suckler bred Charolais bullocks (30m) from Paul Pincombe of Lapford were next up and reached the dizzy heights of £2420 and £2300 whilst strong dairy crossbred Charolais (26m) rose to £2160 for a pair from Andrew Peters and Family of Talaton. Also, later bred Charolais bullocks (16m) ran to £1830 for Jonathan Rich and Family of Yarcombe. Heaps of British Blues steers forward again this Friday when we saw them climb to £2310 apiece for powerful pen of four (23m) from Micheal Tooze of Broadsands whilst six slightly younger Blues (18m) from Steven Slade and Family of Aylesbeare reached £2180 each. More good steers in the way of a pair of Limousins (18m) from Steven Slade and Family looked well sold at £2130 each as did a couple more (22m) from Matthew Wilson in from Dunsford selling just a bid ahead at £2130 with the same seller also parting with a smart Aberdeen Angus bullock (15m) for £2100. Mary and Dan Alford of Tavistock saw well bred and fed Hereford steers (18m) rise to £1980 with two more (17m) from Will Coleman of Lapford coming back at £1900 apiece. Young Simmental bred Steers (15m) from Mark Jones of Widecombe in the Moor eased to £1700 each for a trio and a well grown Beef Shorthorn (26m) from Mary and Dan Alford drew £1700. Plenty of well kept store heifers on offer this week, not least when we saw a super Limousin (28m) return £2260 for David Horton and Family of Roborough, Plymouth and £1960 (24m) for one from John and Helen Keep in from Moretonhampstead. Jonathan Rich and Family were back and selling tidy Charolais heifers (20m) to £1960 followed by later born sorts (15m) of decent quality from Westcott Farms, Tavistock easing to £1580. As with the steers, there was an abundance of first rate South Devon heifers on offer too with the very best (26m) selling to £1950 for Jonathan Lentern, with a pair (24m) not far back at £1880 apiece for Louise Gostling of Hittisleigh. British Blue heifers on the wanted list again this week and selling to £1870 for a pen of four well fed sorts (24m) from Graham Hawkins of Thorverton followed by others at £1840 (27m) for Jonathan Rich and Family and £1830 (22m) for a bunch of five neat sorts Andrew Peters and Family. Better of the other native breed heifers saw £1790 for a bunch of well turned out Herefords (25m) from Jonathan Rich and Family and Aberdeen Angus females (21m) saw £1700 for David Horton and Family.
