Store Steers to £2400 Store Heifers to £2380

Another short entry of store cattle here at Exeter this week sold in front of a huge crowd of buyers both from away and closer to home who managed to whip up just as strong a trade as we have seen of late. A mainly very good quality show saw those older, forward steers and heifers still looking big money although running parallel to the lower finished returns whilst any younger, longer term types looked the trade of the day which was no doubt helped by the recent welcome rain. Steers topped at £2400 given for a grand South Devon cross (26m) from Russell Retter and Family in from Cotleigh followed by further strong South Devon crossbred bullocks from Dave Luckett and Family of Cornwood who saw their pen of five eye catching younger sorts (15m) come back at a creditable £2100 apiece. Also, a couple of smashing purebred South Devon steers (just 14m) from Phillip Norrish of Widecombe in the Moor sparked strong demand when realising £1690 a life. Two pairs of outstanding Simmental steers from Andrew Shervington and Family in from Hittisleigh (25m) also proved to be popular when rising to £2380 and £2360 followed by the better of the many Aberdeen Angus stores of offer when two (21m) steers eased to £2350 for Robert Moore of Diptford and one draw £2300 for Keith Greenslade down from Yeovil. Other good Angus bullocks saw Richard Peeke and Family of Washbourne sell two cracking pens of five (18m) for £2080 and £2040 whilst a later born trio (14m) from Dave Luckett and Family looked well sold at £1960 each. Several top notch Limousin bred steers about this week with top price of those going to David Withers in from Whimple with two (29m) climbing to £2150 a piece followed by three younger sorts (24m) at £1960 for Rob Davies of Diptford and a pair (22m) at £1820 for Russell Retter and Family. Better of the younger store steers not yet mentioned included a tremendous pen of three Welsh Black yearlings at £1670 a life for Phillip Norrish and even later born Charolais steers (just 9 months) of the highest order from Ollie Stephens of Liskeard which flew to £1640 apiece. Rob Davies was back when parting with the top priced heifers on the day with a powerful black Limousin (29m) easily reaching £2380 followed by standout red Limousin females from Chris Lentern of Chagford who parted with one (24m) for £2200 with his older pair (28m) still rising to an impressive £2170 each. Keith Greenslade also returned to see his top South Devon heifer (26m) draw a decent enough £1900 as was Robert Moore who sold four well kept Aberdeen Angus (21m) for £1890 apiece. British Blue heifers up next when we saw a well bred and fed pen from John Searle of Hollacombe top out at £1870 for a pair (22m) with excellent Beef Shorthorn type heifers (22m) from Mary and Dan Alford in from Tavistock reaching £1860 who also saw smart Hereford females (20m) sell to £1850 and British Blondes (15m) at £1700. Also, four neat, matching Charolais heifers (17m) from Rosie Fishleigh of Sourton Cross looked as well sold as anything on the day when fetching £1680 a life as did a shapely yearling Limousin feeding bull from Ed Pincombe of Chulmleigh which made £2280. Some excellence grazing cows on offer on Friday when the very best ran to £2050 for a fine red Limousin from Mel Forward of Talaton whilst John Andrews of Wembury saw grand South Devon barreners to £1920 and Charolais with the same comments just a bid back at £1910.

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
