Prime Cattle to 392ppk and £2737 Cull Cows to 312ppk and £2398

Another super entry of prime and cull cattle on offer here at Exeter this week when we saw finished steers top out at 392ppk given for a shapely 688kg Limousin steer from Adrian and Bradley Bowden in from Drewsteignton which went on to gross £2693. Highest total money realised was a decent enough £2737 (710kg \times 386ppk) for a strong Charolais bullock from Keith and Hilary Harvey of Bovey Tracey followed by a grand Simmental bred steer from Douglas Horton and Family of Kingsbridge which drew £2616 (708kg x 370ppk) and the better of a pair of well turned out South Devon cross bullocks from Martin and Gill Partridge from Christow which levelled out at £2404 (632kg x 381ppk). Prime British Blue heifers headed that section and ran to £2431 (680kg x 358ppk) for Keith and Hilary Harvey with a nicely covered sort whilst further Blues also in good order came back at £2169 (584kg x 372ppk) for Adrian and Bradley Bowden. Over thirty month steers saw an aged (41m) Hereford from Graham and Carol Northmore of Clyst Honiton rise to £2111 (622kg x 340ppk). Several cull cows over that magical £2000 barrier this week with the very best rising to a creditable £2398 (770kg x 312ppk) for a lovely Salers cow from Russell Boundy and Family of Winkleigh whilst Douglas Horton and Family saw a well farmed Aberdeen Angus type ease to £2281 (714kg x 320ppk) and high quality red Limousins ran to £2255 (766kg x 295ppk) for Andrew Cleave of Christow. Andrew Cleave also parted with a smart South Devon barrener for an impressive £2192 (742kg x 296ppk) whilst the better of a fine run of pure bred Simmental cows from Andrew and George Palk up from Marldon sold to £1862 (676kg x 276ppk). Trim, young first calving sort heifers looking well sold with one at £1453 (502kg \times 290ppk) for Steven Slade and Family of Aylesbeare together with another youngster that reached £1322 (502kg x 264ppk) for a neat Salers from Phil Hutchings from Chagford. Keith and Hilary Harvey also parted with a spritely Dexter cull cow for £466 (312kg x 150ppk)

We were expecting around 4500 and we had nearly 5500 sheep in total, sheep trade under pressure but with 10-12 buyers in the varying sections Exeter fared better than some and all sheep forward were accepted and sold.

2552 PRIME SPRING LAMBS

A more difficult day in the sheep pens as numbers of all categories flood out everywhere, lamb trade under pressure as many major retailers are still on the plentiful supply of hoggs, yet their numbers marketed on a

national scale grow daily. This meant the lamb trade was sluggish to start, but became increasingly harder work as the sale went on and reports of weaker sales further north halted some buyers in their tracks.

A few choice pens saw an overweight Charollais lamb at 70kgs from George Dart of Clyst Hydon top the sale at £194 with 53-59kg lambs generally £152 to £165 with birthday boy Robert Mackintosh of Milborne Wick Farms Sherborne reaching £170, a price matched by Ellen Yandle of Oxton and closely followed by husband Tom at £169. Tom also had 49kgs at £166 followed by John Harfoot and family of Callington at £165 as Robin Irwin down from Kings Nympton sold smart 47's at £163.50 and a tremendous single Texel 46kg lamb from Anthony Elsworthy of Witheridge flew to £180 and 391ppk. This great run of pure Charollais, pure Texel and CharTex lambs from Anthony also produced a superb pen of Charollais lambs weighing 40kgs and selling at £171 or a market topping 428ppk whilst 45's realised £168 and 40kg CharTex lambs made £166 (415ppk). 42's to £161.50 again from Robin Irwin as 41's reached £156 for Keith Milton of Pennymoor, a price matched by Matt Baker of Highampton with classy 40kg lambs, equating to 390ppk. Lighter 39kgs to £151 for lack Enticott and family of Wellington whilst Martins Farming of Dunkeswell claimed £144 and both Tom Cole of Heasley Mill and Ian & Sue Tall of Modbury made £143 of the same weight. SQQ 331ppk (back 43p) with an overall average of 324ppk and £140.80 per head back 42p and £15 per head respectively.

1255 PRIME HOGGS & 275 MATURE SHEEP

Another big yarding and a mixed show, unsurprisingly still with plenty of weight about and also the seasonal scruffy sorts but in general trade very similar on the hoggs, maybe a fraction easier, whilst toothers were back £5 or so with less firms interested, particularly for any half meat mature sheep.

Best of the hoggs to £184 for 90kgs from Jack Enticott who had "handier" 72kgs at £163, a price matched by Ed Venning of Fowey with a penful of 66kg hoggs and Nick Harris of Bridport had pens at £160 & £159. Martin and Adam Crabb of Luppitt selling smart 51's at £150 & £144.50 with David Pratt and family selling 50's at £150 and a super double pen of 47kg Texel bred hoggs from Steve Locke of Jacobstowe rose to £143 and 304ppk with another pen of 46's at £142 and 309ppk. 45's to £139 for Jim Summerhayes of Upottery as 43's made £136.50 and a sale topping 317ppk with Graham Doidge of Modbury selling 42's at £130 closely followed by Henry Hayes of South Molton at £129.50. 40's to £122 for Robert & Christine Steer of Avonwick as ST & AM Dennis of Inwardleigh claimed £114 for 39's and 38's rose to £112 for Hawkey Partnership of Broadwoodkelly. Hogg SQQ becoming insignificant with the quality forward but stood at 284ppk with an all in average of 267ppk and £133 per head.

The edge just off the toother trade with a bit less interest unless they're shape and meat. Ticking both those boxes were Ed Venning climbing to £168 as Messrs Priscott & Habberfield of Wiveliscombe sold to £166 and 247ppk with 51's at £126 and Jake Jackson of Moretonhamsptead had 42kgs at £112 or a sale topping 267ppk.

1274 CULL EWES & 81 RAMS

The purple patch of the day with all 12 buyers firing on all accounts and handling the numbers and mixed quality on offer with ease and ensuring a string and level trade throughout. Best Texels in short supply and selling to £355 & £300 for Gareth & Jess Hutchings of Launceston, £298 for Will Braund of Holsworthy and £295 for the Retter family of Cheriton Bishop. A single Charollais ewe achieved £300 for Colin and David Smallacombe of Bow as David & Michelle Wotton of Ashreigney had a Charollais type ewe at £265, David Pratt and family had a Rouge ewe at £258 with both Aplins Farm of Monkton and John Reddaway & sons of Cossick Cross selling crossbred ewes at £258. Heavy Suffolk cross, Texel cross and Dorset ewes regularly £200 to £245 with half meat sorts from £180 to £210 and plainer but healthy sorts back from that but usually three figures and above whilst some real bottom end sorts on realization. Mules dearer on the week with several touching £200 and plenty £170 to £190 with half meats circa £150. Hill ewes seeing Cheviots in the £140's with horned ewes generally £85 to £100 and all included in the overall average of £155. Tups a good shout too with a great trade for the goods on offer with Baker Bros of Highampton selling heavy Longwools at £285 & £230 as well as a shapely Texel at £222. RE & R Leonard of North Tawton claimed £272, David & Jenny Cox of Rackenford at £200 and five further rams sold in the £190's, the boys averaged £140.


