

Store Steers to £2510 Store Heifers to £2020

Excellent numbers of store cattle forward this week considering we are now heading for the quieter summer months with well over 400 penned and sold her at Exeter on Friday. Trade not quite as strong as we have been seeing it although there was nothing wrong with the returns we did see considering the easing finished price. Steers topped at a pretty impressive £2510 given for a pair of outstanding black Limousin steers (30m) from Derek Pyle in from Clyst Honiton with his next offering, a further pen of grand Limousin bullocks of a similar age still reaching £2370 apiece. Later born Limousin steers (25m) from Paul Harris of Lee Mill saw a red one make £2260 whilst yet younger sorts (20m) from Andrew Cleave of Christow saw £1885. South Devon steers next up when a strong single (25m) from Russell Retter and Family, Cotleigh came back at a decent enough £2500 followed by a trio from the same sellers at £2380 apiece and others (23m) selling to £2360 for Frank Gostling, Crediton and younger South Devons (15m) drawing £2300 for Andrew and Phillip Cooke of Widworthy with a striking pen of four. A big, rangy Aberdeen Angus steer (25m) from John Simmons of Poltimore let that breed and saw the hammer fall at £2460 whilst Derek Pyle was back and parting with three very smart British blue steers (30m) for £2390 a head and younger, shapely Blues (19m) rose to £1910 and £1900 for Rob Corkery of Ottery st Mary and EA Maile & Son from Okehampton respectively. John Simmons saw the better of a couple of quality Charolais steers (18m) sell well at £2170 followed by big bunch of eight eye catching British Blonde bullocks (21m) from Brian Davis of St Ive which ran to a creditable £2150 apiece. Derek Pyle saw his towering home bred Friesian steers (30m) sold in groups pass that £2000 barrier when making £2140 and £2110 whilst top priced Hereford steers came from Trevor Daniel of Chawleigh who sold a lovely single (22m) £1950. A pair of very well bred and farmed red Limousin heifers (24m) from Andrew Cleave topped the store heifers when fetching £2020 each closely followed by Aberdeen Angus females at £2000 (19m) for John Simmons and £1990 (15m) for Andrew and Phillip Cooke. John Simmons also sold a super Fleckvieh female (22m) for £1980 and his best pair of Charolais heifers (18m) for £1940 apiece. A strong Friesian heifer (20m) from Lynch Farms, Thorverton came back £1910 whilst more smart British Blonde cattle saw a pen (22m) from Brian Davis reach £1860. Other heifer prices of interest included British Blues (22m) at £1860 for Steven Slade and Family in from Aylesbeare, Herefords (25m) to £1800 for Trevor Crocker and Family of Diptford and South Devons (22m) making £1780 for Edward Foale of Coffinswell. Several grazing type cull cows on offer this week when we saw South Devons reach £1980 for Adcock & Wotton of Moretonhampstead and £1900 for Brittan & Co of South Brent whilst a Hereford cow from EL Smith & Sons of Bridport returned them £1740.

A massive entry of beef breeding cattle sold to a flying trade from start to finish! Buyers from far and wide packed the ringside and cows & calves were in serious demand.

The Sale commenced with the South Devon Breeders Club Sale of pedigree South Devon bulls & heifers. A dozen bulls saw less demand with a top call of 4000gns three times for Mervyn Rowe's Tregondale bull and two from Richard Burrough's Godworthy herd with others to 3400gns for West Prawle Farm and 3000gns for Tim Eustice. Other breeding bulls sold to a strong trade topping at £6600 for a 2019 pedigree Charolais bull from Trevor & Martine Snell of Tipton St John who sold another at £2800. Other Charolais bulls saw two year old bulls to £5200 & £2800 for LW Crocker of Tavistock and £4200 for Barry Clarke of Exeter. Pedigree Limousin bulls sold to £6500 for Patrick Greed of Exeter. Aberdeen Angus bulls to £2300 for Murray Garrett of Okehampton.

The final consignment to disperse the Sidborough Herd of pedigree Limousins on behalf of Cecile & Ruth Partridge of Tiverton sold to a cracking trade topping at £4200, £4000 & £3000 with their 4 maiden heifers selling to £3900, £3600, £3500 & £3400.

The final consignment of pedigree Charolais cattle to disperse the Clarke herd on behalf of Barry Clarke of Exeter sold to super trade with top outfit making £5300 for a 2016 born cow (£3050) with her September born bull calf (£2250). Several other outfits making in excess of £4000 and Cows with young calves at foot topped at £3350, £3050 & £2900.

Trevor & Martine Snell of Tipton St John dispersed their commercial Charolais herd to a flying trade topping at £3300 with others to £3100 x 3, £3050 x 2, £3000 x 9 and the majority between £2700-£3000 averaging a very creditable £1496 per life!

Other cows & calves sold to £2600 for a 2016 born Simmental x cow with a young Simmental bull calf from WJ Gillard & Sons of Drewsteighton and £2150 & £2120 for two Shorthorn heifers with young calves at foot from Luke Wessley of Chagford.

182 STORE HOGGS & NEW SEASON LAMBS


A fairly even split between the 182 store hoggs and new season stores saw the lambs top the trade at £156 for Dorset ewe lambs from Steve & Carol Simmons of Chittlehampton who also had wethers at £150 and Charlie Hutchings and Family of Bradninch sold smart Suffolk cross lambs at £139 & £134 whilst the best of the hoggs reached £139 for the Strong Family of Crockernwell and £136 for Joe Emmett of Denbury. Several bottom end tail enders forward but an average of £101.70 was achieved.

107 GRAZING EWES & 32 EMPTY BREEDING EWE HOGGS

Grazers reached £158 for Leo & Jeanette Bradford of Winkleigh as Steve Francis of South Tawton made £157 & £156 and Nigel and Tissa Haley of Buckfastleigh sold Hampshire ewes at £153. Plenty of other business done between £110 and £139 including hill bred ewes to £135 for Roy Radmore of Sheepstor, £130 for Tim Cowling of St Gennys and some very lean ewes looking well sold over the £100 mark. Three pens of run dry Romney ewe hoggs from Jeremy Andrews of Brompton Regis sold to £156 twice and £140.

356 EWES/HOGGS & 452 LAMBS (808 LIVES)

A great show of 356 couples contained some outstanding sheep that were duly rewarded with very strong prices. Archie Hill of Shepton Mallet sold an outstanding pure Texel FM ewe with tremendous pair of ram lambs at £600 and £200 per life. Matt Wreyford of Blackawton sold 4 Suffolk cross ewes with 7 lambs at £390 an outfit or £142 per life as well as other doubles at £385, £312 & £308 and Becky Honour of Ashburton sold an eyecatching purebred Suffolk FM single well at £342 or £171 per life. A great run of Hogg singles from Brian Clothier and Family of Radstock saw his tremendous Texel's sell at £305, £285 twice, £280 & £265 twice whilst the Suffolk's from the same good home realised £288, £280 & £272 with more than 200 lives from this home averaging close to £140 per life. Plenty of other better bred hogg singles and doubles trading between £250 and £290 whilst some out of the fat hoggs were more like £70 to £100 per life. Hill ewes with lambs a similar trade and often £60 to £70 per life and the overall averages were £250 per outfit or £110.33 per life.


