Store Steers to £2500 Store Heifers to £2050

Store cattle numbers still short, which with the promise of a better finished returns on the horizon and an abundance of grass about only looks to have sparked an even stronger trade with a host of buyers around the ring ensuring all on offer were desperately sought after. Fridays sale was headed by a super run of forward well fed steers from Dan Gould down from Blagdon Hill when Dan saw his very best bullock ease to £2500 for a grand Simmental (17m) followed by his powerful trio of Aberdeen Angus steers (22m) which were close at £2480 apiece and three British Blues (24m) just a bid back at £2470 a life. Further tidy British Blue steers (22m) ran to £2020 for both Robert Moore of Diptford and Jonathan Strout up from Rilla Mill whilst the better of the later born Blues (16m) reached £1870 apiece for a pen of four shapely sorts from Nigel and Harry Tope of Dartmouth. Also, other Angus steers of note saw a well kept one (17m) from Nigel and Harry Tope rise to £2240 and £2060 (19m) for Paul Rusden from Ideford. Peter Hendy up from Staddiscombe, Plymouth parted with a big rangy Charolais steer (23m) for a decent enough £2390 whilst quality yearling Charolais came back at £1760 for Al Watts in from Kentisbeare and £1730 for Darren and Harry Cole of Mary Tavy. Dan Gould was back when parting with an eye catching bunch of three Beef Shorthorn steers (26m) for £2220 a life with Bill Hobbs in from Moretonhampstead also breaking the £2000 barrier when selling a pair of standout Limousin bullocks (26m) for £2060 apiece followed by smart young (14m) Limousins selling at £1700 for LJ Grabham and Sons of Tiverton. Several excellent runs of South Devon steers on show this week, not least when we saw three super types (24m) from Matt Irish of Widecombe in the Moor draw £1960 and four younger (14m) ones at £1900 for the Northey Family of lyybridge. Onto the store heifers where we saw a top of £2050 given for a first class Charolais (18m) from Peter Hendy with well bred and farmed yearling Charolais females still rising to £1640 for Darren and Harry Cole. Aberdeen Angus heifers (19m) reached £1960 for Paul Rusden followed by lovely Simmentals (20m) also making £1960 for Jesse White of Sandford and high calibre British Blues (22m) to £1950 for John Searle of Crediton. Younger Blue heifers (15m) sold readily and to £1940 for Nigel and Harry Tope whilst more quality South Devon cattle from the Northey Family saw their cracking trio of heifers (21m) rise to £1880 each. Best of the rest saw £1880 also given for a pair of stout Hereford heifers (22m) sold on behalf of Colin and Phillip Gibbins in from Feniton with a couple of delightful Salers cross Charolais females (20m) from Michael and James Vooght of Hennock close at £1870 a head.

A better show in terms of quality this week, saw Hereford cross steers from Mel Forward of Talaton top out at £1,680 (9m), with others attaining £1,580. Stabiliser steers from John and Will Dracup of Widecombe in the Moor met a roaring trade realising £1,200 (9 m) with others to £1,110 and £1,080. James Horton of Milton Abbot presented Limousin cross dairy bred types (7 m) which topped at £1,150 with Blues of a similar sort to £1,060. Hazels Farms Ltd down from Templeton hit £1,070 for the dairy bred Limousin cross steers (12 m). Heifers topped out at £1,100 for James Horton presenting dairy bred Limousin crosses (7 m) with similar type Blues off the same good holding levelling at £1,000. Hazels Farms Ltd presented further Blues (11 m) which achieved £990 with Angus to £920. Herefords topped out at £880 (7 m) again from James Horton whilst younger blue heifers this time from AJ & RH Webber of Cullompton (6 m) hit £700. Bulls achieved £770 for J Cornish & Sons down from Wellington presenting Hereford types (9 m).

A smaller entry of dairy cattle saw a cracking trade from start to finish when a **new record** was set for our fortnightly Dairy Sale at Exeter! Martin & Di Webber of Drewsteighton sold a super heifer at a new Centre record price of £4000 for "Willsbro Mitchell Roxy" sired by Aurora Mitchell this lovely heifer was backed with 10 generations of VG or Ex dams. Two fresh Jersey heifers from Gareth & Jess Hutchings of Launceston sold to an exceptional trade topping at £1950 & £1850. Another non registered Jersey heifer which had calved in February and was slow to milk sold very well at £1850 for Bradley & Nicole Davey of Launceston who also sold a British Friesian cow due her third in October for £1620. Pete Warrington of Holsworthy sold to grazing type Friesian heifers at £1500. Carters Lodge Farm Ltd of West Sussex sold a consignment of 19 cows & 9 in calf heifers all due between October & December, the cows topped at £2000 with others to £1700 & £1650 and the British Friesian grazing in calf heifers sold well to £1650 & £1400. A consignment of 19 grazing type British Friesian & Crossbred dry cows from Nigel, Brenda & Richard Tucker of Tiverton sold due in August to Blue to a very strong trade topping at £1900 with others to £1820, £1750, £1720 & £1700 x 3 to average £1534.

246 STORE LAMBS

Just 246 store lambs after last weeks opening sale and despite it being an entry or mainly small lambs they were an easy £7-£8 sometimes £10 dearer on the week. Best lambs very short of requirements with J Meyer of Umberleigh topping the sale at £138 with Valais Blacknose crosses whilst their Dorset achieved £130, as Steve Isaac of Ashwater sold his pen at £136 and Alex Lawler of Nomansland saw his best make £133. Mark Brown and family of Uplowman saw his next draw down behind last week's pounds dearer at £125 and Campbell Hill of Torproint claimed £121 of his best pen. Plenty of small lambs forward trading £75 to £95 and they averaged £101 which isn't a fair reflection of the strength of this trade.

80 GRAZING EWES & GOATS

Grazers a fiery go too with Dr Shelley of Shobrooke selling heavy crossbred ewes at £206, £178 & £165 as well as a pen of four Rams at £177. Also at £177 was Matt Rogers Farming of Yealmpton with a Texel x ewe and T Dyer of Newton Abbot had Easycares at £101. A few pens of young Goats from Pennywell Farm of Buckfastleigh sold to £87, £81 & £80 with younger, lighter and leaner sorts £40 to £50.

10 EWES/HOGGS & 13 LAMBS (23 LIVES)

A real end of season show of couples with just ten outfits forward selling to great interest and bidding for the time of year. Newton Abbot YFC sold their last outfit for the year with a Mule double at £250 closely followed by Winkleigh Farming & Grazing with very young lambs on an old Mule at £210, a price matched by Tony England of Tiverton with Mule hogg singles. Mary Curtis of Cadeleigh sold a forward FM single at £208 & Ray Tucker of Bridford with a young double at £200. The averages pales into insignificance at this time of year, more notable is the figure of 4121 outfits (equating to nearly 10,000 lives) sold here in Exeter since October last year, and averaging nearly £110 per life.


