Store Steers to £2400 Store Heifers to £2090

A few more store cattle forward this week here at Exeter with those extra numbers easily eaten up by the large crowd of purchasers who ensured demand was just as high as we have seen it through these summer months. Steers topped at a very creditable £2400 given for the finest of an eye catching run of Charolais (30m) from Paul Pincombe of Lapford closely followed by a smart trio (26m) from Paul which were close at £2370 apiece. Also, a couple of much later born Charolais bullocks (14m) from April Haydon up from South Pool, Kingsbridge looked decent money at £1960 a life. Hereford steers up next when a strong pair (25m) from Steve Snell of Ashreigney shot to £2290 a head whilst Antony Rew and Family up from Newton Abbot parted with their smart Hereford (28m) for £2100. These were followed by South Devon bullocks off the same farm and of a similar age at £2180 and £2170. Younger sorts of those breeds (15m) saw South Devons ease to £1780 for John and Andrew Ball of Stoke Gabriel and £1560 for Johnn Jordan and Family of Gidleigh whilst three well summered Hereford steers from Terry Bowden and Family of Tedburn st Mary rose to £1500 apiece. Tremendous British Blue steers (all round the 22-24m mark) ran to £2130 for John Hallett of Ottery st Mary with others not far back at £2110 for Jonathan Rich and Family of Yarcombe and £2040 for Graham Hawkins of Thorverton together with a couple more at £2000 for David and Andrew Mortimer in from Sowton Village. Anthony Rew and Family returned to sell Friesian steers (30m) to a decent enough £2070 as did John and Andrew Ball who parted with a shapely Aberdeen Angus bullock (21m) for £1860 whilst young (14m) Angus reached £1660 for a super pen of five from Steve Hallett of Sidbury. Further later born store steers saw lovely runs of Limousin sell readily and to £1660 (14m) for Anne Quiney and Simon Spears of Moretonhampstead, £1500 (10m) for John Jordan and Family and £1840 (12m) for April Hayden. Plenty of well bred and farmed store heifers on show this week with a top of £2090 given for a solitary suckler bred Limousin (16m) of high quality from Anne Quiney and Simon Spears whilst dairy bred Limousins (22m) in excellent order from Messrs Fooks Brothers of Bridport reached £1880 a head for a pen of four. Messrs Fooks Brothers also sold standout Aberdeen Angus females (22m) to £2030 with similar describes sorts sold by Jonathan Rich and Family grossing £1860 who also saw their best British Blue (24m) fetch £1890. Other well farmed Blue heifers (22m) sold in bunches to £1920 and £1900 for Roger Semmens of St Buryan, Penzance. Cull cows sold to a top of £2350 for a stout Aberdeen Angus from ECF & M LTD of Braunton

A decent show of stirks and suckled calves met another roaring trade with the best topping out at £1480 for a pen of Limouins (11m) and a second pen of Bazadaise cross steers (11m) achieving £1350 both from Campbell & Jackie Hill of Torpoint. Simmental steers from the Morris Family in from Northlew topped out at £1430 (13m). Charolais crosses topped out at £1310 for Phil and Tom Medland up from Brentor (8m), whilst a wonderful run from Quick and Sons down from West Monkton saw dairy bred Blue steers (7m) top out at £1300 with others (7m) achieve £1200 whilst Angus steers of the same good farmer (9m) attained £1120. Young Limousin cross steers (9m) from Steve & Angela Dennis of Okehampton achieved £1020 plus further native types this time from Holland Farmers from Tavistock saw Angus steers (7m) top out at £960 with Herefords of a similar ilk attaining the same figure. Young Charolais cross steers (3m) from Richard Langdon down from South Molton attained £930 with Limousins(3m) from the same good farmer attaining £880. Heifers topped out at £1010 for Quick & Sons, presenting good pens of Angus crosses (10m) with others to £940. Steve & Angela Dennis sold Limousin cross heifers (4m) which topped out at £920 also Charolais types (7m) from Phil and Tom Medland topped out at £880. Laarveld and J A Pidgeon of Exeter realized £870 for Angus heifers (10m) whilst Holland Farmers levelled out at £800 for Hereford cross types (7m) good well fleshed Blue stirks from lack Perry of Blackawton attained £780 (5m) with others off the same good farm achieving £740.

Another 100 plus calves penned this morning and what a difference a week makes. Trade takes a lift on last week with many calves up £100/head today! AJ & JA Lock of Cullompton topped the section with a superb run of calves with their best Blue bull hitting a decent £668, others from the same stable making £610 x2, £600 x3 and £565. Other good Blue bulls at £550 for Steve Hallett, Sidbury and £530, £518 and £500 for Towhill Farm Ltd, Broadclyst. All Blue bulls average a impressive £513!! A smashing Simmental bull reached £602 for a young sort in from MR & KM Pring, Broadclyst followed by older Angus bulls to £500 for Broom & Son, Cullompton, others £410 and £405 for AR Hooper & Partners LTD. Strong Limousin bulls to £478 for Towhill Farm Ltd followed by Herefords at £460 for G Kemp, Wellington and £380 for David Headon and Family. Just the one Charolais bull in the mix today and that one made £460 for Besley Dairy.

Heifers raced up to £560 for AJ & JA Lock for their best Blues, more from them selling well at £505 and £475. Others at £460 for RJ & KL Emmett, South Molton, £440 for DW Cole, Bradninch, £440 Towhill Farm Ltd and £430 for JW Davies and Sons of Uplowman. A bunch of 5 strong Angus heifers returned at £425 for Broom & Son others to £380 for AR Hooper. Hereford heifers made £420 for Les and Tracey Rockett, Bridestowe and £390 for David Headon again.


