Store Steers to £2450 Store Heifers to £2520

Nothing wrong with the store cattle trade here at Exeter this week with all on offer looking a sharper trade on the week particularly the well bred middling steers and heifer which sold just as well as we've seen them. Plenty of buyer power ringside once again with cattle evenly shared both between buyers from away and those closer to home. Store steers topped out at a very impressive £2450 given for a couple of outstanding, well covered black Limousin bullocks (24m) from John and Emily Northam of Wellington followed into the ring by an older, rangy Limousin (26m) from the same sellers at £2410. Later born Limousin steers selling to a premium this week when a pair of striking sorts (14m) from William Bromell, Chagford easily reaching £2100 apiece and a further two with similar comments flying to £1910 for Gerald and Linda Heywood down from Rackenford. Also, five very smart yearling Limousin steers (out of pure bred Simmental cows) ran to £1560 a life for Malcolm and Kim Coumbe up from Lamellion. Adam and Kate Partridge travelled in from Poundsgate and saw their two grand South Devon steers (20m) ease to £2240 apiece whist their super trio of British Blues (20m) drew a creditable £2200 each. Other Blue steer prices of note included a pen of four powerful sorts (20m) which came back at £2021 for Winston and Gaynor Thorne of Umberleigh whilst cracking young (14m) Blues ran to £1500 for a pen of four from Messrs Prettejohn and Freeman of Ottery st Mary. More top quality young store steers (14m) hit £1790 and £1770 for bunches of well bred and farmed Charolais from Luke and Hannah Fursdon of Poundsgate followed by well kept Hereford bullocks of the same age at £1660 apiece for a pen of five from Terry Bowden and Family of Tedburn st Mary. Well turned out Aberdeen Angus bullocks (18m) from Robin Milton and Family down from West Ansty saw a deserved £1680 and a pen of five lofty Brown Swiss steers (22m) realised £1670 a life for Matthew and Louise Coates of Saltash. For once the store heifers outdid the steers when peaking at £2520 for as a good a pen of black Limousin heifers (24m) you will see in these parts from John and Emily Northam followed by more Limousin females (22m) of high order at £1930 and £1890 for John and Helen Keep of Moretonhampstead and £1800 for a trio of good sorts (18m) from WE Petherick from Petrockstowe. Also, more of those smart spring 2024 Limousin cross youngsters from Malcolm and Kim Coumbe returned £1600 for a bunch of three and a further three from Gerald and Linda Heywood saw £1480 each. Charolais heifers up next when drawing £2390 for an eye catching sort (25m) from Trevor and Martine Snell in from Tipton st John with a younger Charolais matched up with a British Blue (20m) realising £1790 for WE Petherick and later again born sorts (14m) making £1460 for more well kept types from Luke and Hannah Fursdon. Good Devon heifers (29m) off Manaton and from the Fitzgerald Family picked up £1770 and the better of several runs of British Blue heifers (18m) racked up £1740 for EA Maile and Son of Okehampton and £1640 for Robin Milton and Family. Aberdeen Angus females (18m) ran to £1520 for Peter Vooght of South Brent.

A quieter day in the sheep pens as expected for the time of year but tidy entries in each section met with similarly strong trades all round. 24 orphan lambs consisted of mainly stronger end weaned sorts that sold away well to tops of £85 for a pair from R Foster of Stoke St Gregory who also had another pair at £78 and Charlie Hutchings and family of Bradninch sold a trio at £75. Smaller nearly weanable sorts in the £30's and they averaged £45 overall.

210 STORE HOGGS & NEW SEASON STORES

A tidy number of stores comprised mainly of new season lambs with a bit more strength about this week selling to £146, £133, £130 & £121 twice for Messrs Priscott & Habberfield of Wiveliscombe as Charlie Hutchings and family of Bradninch sold shapely lighweight springers at £126, £124 & £116 as the Burrough family of Axminster sold theirs at £117. Best of the hoggs to £151 for J Elworthy of Barnstaple with a pen of six as well as another three at £125 and hogg with teeth up at £117. Only two more weeks of selling store hoggs separate, there after they will go in with the grazing ewes.

On to the ewes and just 60 of these forward today but meeting another fast trade with all lots keenly bid for reaching a top of £144 for half meat crossbred ewes from the Burrough family whilst half meat Mules made £120 for the Jemmison family of Brayford, a price matched by Emma Pitts of Cheriton Bishop with very similar goods. Tanya Reed of Wincanton sold Herdwicks in large pens at £84 & £78 and more ewes needed for Monday please.

183 EWES/HOGGS & 211 LAMBS (394 LIVES)

Nearly 200 outfits on offer this week and again trade just very similar as demonstrated by Brian Clothier and family of Radstock with their fine run of hogg single couples averaging with pence of last week at £139 per life. Their Texel x Mule singles sold in pens of ten realised £295, £285 (x3), £280 & £270 as well as their best pen of Suffolk crosses at £275. Young farmer John Steer of Ashburton topped the day with two first time lambing black twins at £365 or £122 per life whilst the Steer family sold forward BM singles at £270 and a Suffolk x hogg double at £250. Tony England of Tiverton sold Mule hogg singles at £260 & £240 whilst Olly Eavis of Exeter sold a milk one side single well at £242. Outfits averaged £223.50 per couple and £104 per life.




