An excellent quality line up of store cattle for our monthly sale of restricted cattle was headed by a remarkable run of well farmed dairy crossbred steers and heifers from Alan Hembrow and Family of Lostwithiel who saw tremendous bunches of Charolais steers (24m) top the sale when drawing £2580, £2570 and £2470 these were followed by a couple of fine suckler bred Charolais bullocks (just 13m) from Phillip Rawle down from Parracombe who parted with his best pair for an impressive £2020 apiece. Alan Hembrow and Family were back when selling sublime Limousin bred steers (26m) for £2460 whilst Hereford bullocks (22m) from Ken Headon of Seven Crosses eased to £1610 a head for a decent bunch of four. A matching pair of Friesian and Norwegian Red steers (23m) from Ray Middleton and Family of Woodbury reached £1220 each. More of those grand Charolais from Alan Hembrow and Family headed the store heifer section with lovely bunches all around the 24m mark racing away to £2310, £2290 and £2280 followed by their shapely pair of Hereford heifers of the same age which came back at £2060 a life. A further offering of those eye catching beef bred Charolais from Phillip Rawle looked well sold when his heifers (15m) drew £1860 apiece for a pair. Also, smaller dairy bred Hereford females (23m) ran to £1300 and £1180 for Ken Headon and Ray Middleton and Family respectively.


