Store Steers to £2500 Store Heifers to £2280

A super quality entry of store cattle here at Exeter this week with demand as strong as ever with those younger, poorer dairy bred types looking just as well sold as their stronger better beef bred counterparts. Trade looks partly to driven by some purchasers concerned that there may be another lift in prices in the new year as we have traditionally witnessed over the last few years. Store steers topped at a very worthy £2500 given for a grand eye catching Stabiliser (30m) from Richard Sweet in from Dunsford followed by sublime Charolais bred steers (19m) making £2290 for Phillip and Richard Coaker of Postbridge and £2270 for David Mingo from Fenny Bridges. Younger Charolais steers (14m) still ran to £1780 for Ron Wonnacott and Sons of Chagford. Richard Sweet was soon back when parting with a smart Limousin bred bullock (30m) for £2250 with a couple of solid looking later born sorts (26m) of the same breed reaching £2180 for Jonathan Strout up from Rilla Mill and younger again ones (18m) from Jesse White of Sandford easing to £2010. Two super runs of South Devons from regular sellers saw a tidy pen of six (22m) rise to £2230 apiece for Steve Cane of Spriddlestone, Plymouth and four more with similar comments (18m) from Phillip and Richard Coaker draw £2100 a life whilst Jonathan Strout sold top prices British Blues steers (25m) for £2170 and Herefords (26m) at £2100. Aberdeen Angus steers (24m) returned £1980 for Paul Rusden of Ideford followed by Friesians (26m) just a bid back at £1970 for Andrew and Michaela Rodd of Lapford. Also, Wagyu steers (28m) came back at £1950 for David and Michelle Wootton of Ashreigney with a neat Simmental (20m) from Jesse White making the same amount. An entry of much stronger store heifers about this week with those seeing a top of £2280 for a tremendous pen of four Charolais (20m) from Barry Mildon and Family of Cadbury with another smart bunch off the same farm seeing five make £1990 apiece. Further Charolais bred heifer of high order saw one (18m) from Phillip and Richard Coaker fetch £2050 and another of a similar age pick up £1990 for Odstone Farm of Sticklepath. Steve Cane was back when selling more of his impressive South Devons, this time parting with four stout heifers (23m) for £2000 a head, Rusden was also back and sold Aberdeen Angus heifers to £1980 for a trio (24m). Other Angus heifer prices of note included ones (25m) at £1930 for Fred Chanin in from Thorverton and a pair of slightly younger sorts (22m) from John Harris and Family of Zeal Monarchorum reaching £1870 apiece. Not a great deal of strength in the British Blue heifers this week, although we did see a shapely type (20m) from Paul Belworthy of Exeter rise to £1790 and a lovely bunch of seven (18m) close at £1760 each for Toby and Beverley Boys up from East Allington whilst young Limousins (20m) saw £1750 for both David and Mary Stark of Denbury and Jogn Harris and Family. Just a handful of grazing cows about this Friday with the best running to £1600 for a fine South Devon from Trevor Adcock and Family in from Moretonhampstead.

Trade firing on all cylinders again here at Exeter for our late season show and sale of suckled calves. Tony Francis of Okehampton sold Angus steers just (7m) which topped out at £1590 with Simmental steers of a similar ilk to £1540. L Bryant of Crediton sold further Angus steers (10m) to £1530 whilst a run of super South Devon steers from Trigger Passy of Plymouth attained £1430 (8m) with others to £1280 (8m). Josh Webber of Yarcombe sold dairy bred Blue steers (12m) to £1380 whilst Nigel Willmington of Ide sold Angus steers topping out at £1370 (8m). Further South Devon steers from Trevor Adcock of Moretonhampstead (5m) raced to £1360. Miles & Helen Partridge of Poundsgate sold British Shorthorns (10m) to £1340, the same figure achieved for Tim Whitley of Widecombe in the Moor selling Charolais steers (8m) to £1340. Hereford steers from Trevor Rowland of Plymouth (9m) also selling to £1340. South Devon steers from Tim Whitley levelled out at £1300 (7m) whilst the Wonnacott Family of Chagford presented Charolais cross steers (12m) which attained £1220. Heifers topped out at £1270 for Tim Whitley selling Charolais cross heifers (7m) with South Devon heifers from Trevor Adcock attaining £1240 (8m) and scopey Hereford heifers (9m) from Trevor Rowland realising £1220. Simmental heifers from R White of Coleford levelled out at £1210 (9m) whilst younger Simmental heifers from Tony Francis hit £1180. Dairy bred Blues from lan Serpell of Plympton topped out at £1180 (14m) whilst WJ Gillard & Sons of Drewsteignton sold their Blue heifers (7m) to £1100.

Sheep pens were busy again this week with another 3163 forward and sold to strong trades yet again in all sections.

8 ORPHAN LAMBS

Just 8 orphan lambs to kick things off sold to £60 twice, firstly for Alan Bickley of Puddington whilst Jonathan Cuming of Feniton made £60 & £52 of his and David and Adrian Cole had young sorts at £50 & £48 and they averaged just over £48!

2377 STORE LAMBS

Fewer stores than we've seen for a month at 2377 but still a pleasing number on the year and sold to a pleasing enough trade given the stagnant prime trade and abhorrent weather. Best pens still top side of £150 to a top of £156 for Shaun Carter of Ottery St Mary whilst his mother Della was close up behind at £150 with a large pen. David and Lynda Pellow of Sourton sold their four pens well at £154 twice, £152 & £148, Denis Tapp of Rackenford had a big pen at £154 whilst messrs Browse of Butterleigh had a single at £150 and Cadeleigh Farm Co. of Tiverton sold a large pen well at £149. Farming lambs still all £120 to £138 with the short keep sorts upwards from there and longer term lambs now more realistic and trading £88 to £108 depending on breed and condition. Somebackwards sorts and harder farmed sorts back from that but still a respectable average of £117 was achieved

Almost 200 grazers and a pleasing trade overall with some weightless shelly genuine grazers looking very very well sold around £100 mark despite some farmer grazing buyers getting filled up. Best sorts to £176 for GJ & HR Browse of Butterleigh, £170 for Texel crosses & £157 for the Suffolk crosses from Neil & Kate Lethbridge of Totnes, £160 for Jim Powell of Holne and £157 for Scotch Mules from the Clements family of Worlington. Tups to £158 for Geoff Arscott of Chagford and several hill ewes looking well sold with Cheviots to £136 and Whitefaced Dartmoors to £102.

538 BREEDING EWES & EWE LAMBS

The December sale of in lamb ewes saw just over 500 forward and sale and met with another fast trade following on from last month, with all 538 sold levelling at just shy of £230 apiece! Following on from the last sale John Attree of Harbertonford dispersed the last of his flock of Charollais crosses and peaked at £305, £282, £272 and £265 to average £277 of his consignment. Gareth & Jess Hutchings of Launceston sold their early lambers with three pens of Dorset x Mule shearlings at £300 apiece, pedigree Dorset's at £275 and Suffolk cross flock aged ewes at £268 whilst his father Merv Hutchings sold Suffolk and Texel cross shearlings well at £265 (x3) and Brian and Ian Johnson of Whitchurch Canonichorum sold two large consignments here today with flock aged Polled Dorset's to £270, Dorset Horns to £240 twice and FM Mules to £238 twice. They also had Suffolk and Texel cross shearlings sell well at £255 & £250 x3 as well as flock aged March lambers which peaked at £255 x3 for the crossbreds and £230 x2 for the Mules.

A smaller than anticipated entry of couples completed the day with the 16 outfits forward selling to a yet again a dearer trade and highs of £420 for GMA Chugg of Colyton with a Dorset double who also had a Dorset single at £300. Jonathan Cuming sold two lots of doubles at £410 as well as singles to £290 and Alan Bickley had his Dorset FM doubles to £405 & £395 with averages of £367 per outfit and £130.55 per life.


