

Prime Cattle to 450ppk and £2795 Cull Cows to 272ppk and £2364 Incorporating our annual Christmas Prime Stock Show and Sale of Unhaltered Cattle

A tremendous yarding of prime cattle and cull cows forward for our annual show and sale with a big entry strewn with the very best offering from our valued regular Monday vendors and other local producers. Cattle judge Archie Rowe of RJ Trevarthen, Butchers of Roskrow did an expert job in selecting the best butchers cattle sections and picked out a tremendous young Charolais in the continental bred heifer class from regular supporter Tom Yandle of Oxton for first place which at 622kg and 450ppk came back at a mighty £2795. Toms well covered heifer was also awarded overall champion in the show. Second prize in the continental heifer section went to further frequent market users Adrian and Bradley Bowden in from Drewsteignton who parted with a sublime Limousin for £2668 (668kg \times 400ppk) followed by another smart Limousin from Simon Ward of Iddesleigh with returned £2393 (634kg x 378ppk). First prize winner in the continental steer class and reserve in show came from Andrew Gale and Family of Newton Abbot with an immaculate Limousin which ran out at £2795 (636kg x 440ppk) followed by a trim home bred Charolais off the same farm coming second in that same class and drawing £2726 (674kg x 405ppk) with Simon Ward presenting a further trim Limousin steer (third in class) which sold for a creditable £2611 (674kg x 388ppk). Some excellent bullocks in the native breed steer section where we saw a well bred and fed Aberdeen Angus cross South Devon from Phil Tully of Brixham scoop first prize before going on to realise £2202 (596kg x 370ppk) followed by second and third this that class when Adrian and Bradley Bowden sold a neat Devon bred steer for £2163 (570kg x 380ppk) and Rosie Fishleigh of Sourton saw her shapely Aberdeen Angus rise to £2087 (568kg x 368ppk). Another good bodied Aberdeen Angus from Nick Parkinson of Burrington was deservedly adjudged best native bred butchers heifer and sold readily for £2202 (616kg x 358ppk). Winner for the award for the best cull cow in the show was given to a very well-bred red Limousin from Nick Hill down from Shepton Mallett and at a massive 884kg she came back at 268ppk and £2364. Peter Hooper in from Bovey Tracey sent us a couple of well kept British Blue barreners and saw the better of the two rise to £2339 (912kg x 257ppk) whilst a fine South Devon from Michael Scott of Drewsteignton reached £2331 (942kg x 248ppk). A solid looking Hereford cow from Aimee Mogford in from Nomansland sold well and for £2144 (790kg \times 272ppk) as did the Best Simmental cow from Richard Beckley of Black Dog when she hit £2014 (834kg x 242ppk).

Away from the show and overweights reached £175 & £170 for David Crocombe and family of Muddiford, £174 for Jonny Bell of Diptford, £173 for Denis Jones and family of Heasley Mill, £172 for Ellan Yandle of Oxton and £170 for Mark Harvey of Slapton. Gwen & Stephen Renfree sold a pair of non show lambs at 52kgs that rose to £175 and Mark Walter of Bradworthy sold the pick of his lambs at £170 for 47kgs (362ppk) and Paul & Lin Calfraft had a single 44kg at £165 and a non show topping 375ppk as well as 43's at £157 (365ppk) and Kevin Seymour had a smart pen of 44kg lambs at £156.50. One short of 600 cull sheep met another steady trade although the Christmas show brought forward a few better pens, the like of which we haven't seen in recent weeks and those ewes sold to an improved trade. Pure Texel's sold to a top of £308 and £294 for two pairs from Kevin & Becky Matthews of Launceston who also had another at £238 and pen of thicker sorts at £228. More pure Texel's at £295 for the first prize pen of five from the Neale Family of Launceston whilst second prize went to the Bealey family of Torrington and made £182 and Mark Harvey of Slapton had third prize continental ewes at £194. Other continental ewes at £232 for a pair of Charollais types from Rob Hopper and family of Cove as Paul & Lin Calcraft sold two Beltex ewes and then a Charollais cross ewe at £230, the Bealey family with a heavy Charollais type ewe at £200 and Sue Veysey of Cullompton with her best ewes at £197. The show for pens of native bred ewes was won by Denis Jones and family with their Suffolk x Mules at £210 as well as non show ewes from the same home at £206, John Cowell of Black Dog came second with a pen of heavy Dorset's at £195 and third place went to Ian Widdicombe of Berry Pomeroy with Suffolk crosses at £170. Other Suffolk crosses to £195 for Phillip and Peter Rowell of Crockernwell as Mules peaked at £157 for Denis Jones and family and no real superstars in the hill ewes saw Duncan Campbell of Dorset sell Scotch Blackface ewes to £96 and a ring full of 41 Shetland ewes made £49 apiece for JJ Kendal of Liskeard. Rams to £220 again for the Bealey family, £200 for Alex & Jack James of Shaftesbury and plenty more business done between £140 and £170. Ewes averaged £133 up nearly £19 on last week and rams averaged £131, up £15.
