Store Steers to £2460 Store Heifers to £2320

An excellent entry of store cattle on show here at Exeter this week, especially considering the time of year when numbers would usually have eased by now. Once again Friday saw strong buyer support both from away and closer to home with a packed ringside seeing every steer and heifer on offer keenly sought after, regardless of type, age or quality. A tremendous run of Limousin bred steers (19m) from Matthew Ellis up from Lelant headed that section when his pair eased to a creditable £2460, and a further six reached £2280 apiece whilst further high quality Limousin bred Limousin bullocks of a similar age drew £2180 and £2070 for Chris Chudley of Torbryan and Andrew Cleave, Hennock respectively. Some top notch Charolais bred store steers on offer again this week with the very best (18m) reaching £2300 for both Peter Hendy of Plymouth and Barry Mildon and Family in from Cadbury whilst well farmed Aberdeen Angus steers (26m) ran to £2260 for R & P Farming, Mamhead and £2110 (20m) for a couple sold on behalf of Leo Mitchell of lyybridge. The pick of the British Blues ran to £2120 (21m) for Matt and Kelly Reeve up from Halwell with the same duo also selling Hereford steers (20m) to £2060, with Ian Pedrick of Kingsbridge also selling Herefords of that age for a couple of bids more at £2090. Chris Chudley was back when selling smart South Devon steers (18m) to £1990 followed by the better of the several Simmental steers on offer (20m) at £1980 for Jago Pascoe up from West Cornwall. Limousins also headed the store heifer section when an well turned out, eye catching black one (18m) from Dan Gould of Taunton easily reached £2320 whilst others in good order and born around the same time came back at £2080 for Jesse White in from Sandford. Also, later born Limousin females (16m) from Geoff and Marie Sharam of Dartmouth sold readily and to £1960. Excellent South Devon bred heifers £19m) returned a very decent £2210 for Chris Chudley and £2140 for Dan Gould whilst super British Blues (18m) drew £2050 for Steven Slade and Family of Aylesbeare and younger (13m) ones looked good money at £1540 for Andrew and Ben Cullen of Upton Pyne. Strong Charolais heifers (18m) from Peter Hendy saw a brisk trade when fetching £2010 apiece for a pen of four followed by further pen of four forward heifers in the way of British Blondes (20m) at £1970 for Dan Gould. Also, tidy Aberdeen Angus heifers (18m) ran to £1750 for Ed Pincombe in from Chulmleigh and younger (14m), well looked after Angus sold to £1520 for Brian and Richard Merchant of Landscove. Some really decent older stock bulls on offer on Friday through the store ring with a grand Aberdeen Angus from Ed and Julie Williams of Ilsington reaching £2400 and a big Simmental making £2320 for Bernie Serpell of Plympton whilst Ed and Julie Williams also sold good grazing cows to £1600 for Herefords and £1580 for a trio of Aberdeen Angus. Pairs of well bred but lean South Devon barreners looked as dear as anything sold on the day with pairs running to £1580 for Phil and Tom Medland of Tavistock.

A super entry of Beef Breeding Cattle which included the first Society supported Sale of Pedigree Beef Shorthorn Cattle. The sale attracted a huge crowd of buyers and a cracking trade was seen from start to finish.

Messrs FG & FM Saunders of Templeton sold a consignment of in calf cows to disperse their herd, they sold to an excellent trade with strong demand topping at £2400 for a 2018 born Limousin cow due in April with other similar cows to £2150, £2020 & £2000 twice.

A massive show of 3363 stores taking us to just 100 short of 9,000 over the last three Fridays were indeed the trade of the day. Despite a few regular faces missing there were plenty of fresh local and travelled buyers making up for it and some leaving short of requirements or having not started at all, even with the larger than expected entry. Top money of £169 going to the Barry & Rachel Mildon of Cadbury who sold others at £153 whilst Tom Elliott of Winkleigh sold a cracking run of killable lambs at £155 twice, £153, £152 and genuine stores at £146 and Herbie Morgan of Kingsbridge sold his best sizable stores at £147 twice and £144.50. Phillip Heard and family of Meldon, Okehampton followed up on last week's success with shorn Suffolk x Lambs at £144 twice followed closely by Andy O'Brien of Whimple at £142.50 and John May down from Bideford sold the best of his run of 322 Suffolk x Mules at £141.50 & £139.50. Medium lambs trading £122 to £135 with smaller longer term lambs still pretty much all top side of £100 except for riff raff, indifferently bred and the very plain lame or lazy. All lambs averaged £120.55 which is down a couple of pounds on the week but due mainly to quality with trade for all shapes and sizes just as hot throughout the sale which took barely two hours.


