- 1. Class 1 Dogs, trained or part trained to be demonstrated.
- 2. Class 2 Dogs young and untrained.
- 3. Class 3 Puppies
- 4. ENTRY FEE: £10.00 exclusive of VAT (entry fee will be refunded if the dog is sold at the event) No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee.
- 5. COMMISSION: Vendors will be charged 5% commission on all lots.
- 6. All dogs shall be warranted sound and good for work and of sound vision.
- 7. Dogs shall be safe with children.
- 8. If a dog injures a sheep in the sale, the owner of the dog will be responsible for recompense to the owner of the sheep.
- 9. Any dog in the sale that is not under control or is gripping sheep shall be stopped at the discretion of the stewards.
- 10. Any dog handled in a language that is not English shall be declared.
- 11. No warranty is given that any dog will work in any particular manner for the purchaser.
- 12. The dogs purchased must be paid for on the fall of the hammer and before removal from the sale field.
