1018 OLDER EWES

After the shortage of older ewes and flying trade at the July Fair a month ago, this sale there were many more catalogued and spread out throughout the sale however all classes still very warmly received. Top money of £255 going to a smart pen of Suffolk x FM ewes from Tom & Leh Cole of Heasley Mill who also had Cheviot Mule FM's at £230, more Suffolk cross ewes at £250, this time for 4T aged ewes from Sue Cleave & Son Farming of Moretonhampstead whilst lan and Catherine Smerdon of Denbury sold a nice pen of Suffolk x FM's at £242. Texel x FM ewes to £230 & £210 for the best of a genuine run from Ivor Alexander of Tiverton, whilst Jamie Acton of Cheriton Fitzpaine sold 4T aged Texel crosses at £220 and Derek & Ashley Purchase of Bratton Fleming had a large pen of Texel x FM's at £200. A super run of genuine flock aged Romney and Romney cross ewes from Mark Vian of St Austell saw his 4T's sell in large pens at £198, £195 & £185 whilst his 6T's made £180 & £175 and three pens of FM's were £165, £162 & £150. The annual consignment of FM Mules from Ian Johnson and Family of Bridport led the older Mule section with his large pens of strong genuine ewes selling at £195, £190, £185 and £180 and all his 131 FM's averaged £184. Other FM Mules at £188 again for Tom & Leh Cole and £180 for Roger and Tanya Heggadon of Broadwoodkelly who also sold their beloved Zwartbles at £190 & £185.

2419 NC MULE SHEARLINGS

A much larger show of Mules on the year with numbers up around 50% from 1800 forward and sold last year to nearly 2500 forward this year and only a handful of pens not finding new homes. A large crowd of entirely farmer buyers from across the Westcountry welcomed the varied line up of shearlings and trade on the whole decent throughout given the varied reports of sales elsewhere over the past few weeks. First prize in the show went to James and Lucy Bosley of Uplowman, Tiverton with a tremendously well turned out run of 133 that saw their first prize pen sell at £245 with an average of £228 for their fine run. Second prize went to Emily Pearse of Colebrooke with yet another good run of well turned out shearlings that saw her first pen make £260. next pen make £250 and all 88 averaged £244. Third prize rosette went to Evershott Farms of Abbotsbury who saw tops of £238, £235, £230 twice and averaged five pounds better than last year at £224 for all 279 they sold. Also worthy of mentions were the tremendous run of 254 good dark headed shearlings from Maurice Hockridge of Crediton that rose to £250 and £245 for his best and didn't sell a pen under £220 to level at £233 for his run and all John Simons of South Chard, Mark Johnson and Family of Bridport and Pete and Angela Smerdon of South Brent sold their best at £240. Plenty of good straight farming sorts perhaps a pound or two less on the year and £195 to £210 with more second quality sorts forward this year trading from £165 to £190 and pulling the average back £4 to £205 overall. Congratulations and thanks to all vendors on a wonderful show and our sincere thanks to the days judge, Miss Maddie Sizmur for her time and expertise.

Two pens of smart Exmoor Mule shearlings sold at £190 & £170 for Simon Payne of Taunton as Masham shearlings reached £188 for Sam Hutchings of Bradninch and a run of homebred Welsh Mule shearlings sold to £172 & £170 for Ray Vincent of Watchet.

110 CHEVIOT MULES

A pair of smart Black Cheviot Mule shearlings from the Jordan Family of Chagford topped the section at £320 whilst their pen of 25 strong white homebred sorts made £272 and others at £235. Ron Manning of North Tawton made £242 of his good pen and Potticks Pigs Ltd, down from Bath realised £220 with a section average of £237.

913 SUFFOLK X MULE SHEARLIINGS

Another strong line up and another strong trade! Roger Rottenbury of Black Dog picked up where he left off in July with his three pens at £245, £242 & £240, likewise, lan Johnson and Family started off at £235 & £230 and Richard Coward down from Mere sold his two pens at £232 & £228. First draw Suffolk crosses from Ashley Game Farm of Chulmleigh rose to £235, £230 & £225 to average £221 of their 180 sold and all Suffolk x shearlings averaged a respectable £218.

87 PUREBRED & FIRST CROSS SHEARLINGS

As last sale the stand out run from Paul Quick and Family of Crediton dominated the top prices with pure Texel's at £360, pure Charollais at £330 a pen of tremendous Suffolk x Texel's also at £330 and a pen of CharTex at £300. Brian Cornish of Westleigh sold Charollais shearlings at £320 & £260, Russell Stevens of Crediton had a pen of ¾ Bred Texels at £280, Steve Dennis of Bow sold CharTex shearlings at £270 and Ollie Eavis of Exeter sold a pair of Suffolk Shearlings at £250.

302 TEXEL X MULE SHEARLINGS

Not just as many on offer and a much better trade with a section average of £219.95! Winstoen Thorne topping with a super pen at £258, Mark Johnson and Family with no less than six pens at £242, Ian Johnson and Family with their best at £240 & £236 and Rob & Rebecca Jordan of Chagford had Texel x BFL's at £238. Peter Gillard of Tedburn St Mary tidied up his Texel's for the year at £230 and Jon & Helen Putt of Tedburn St Mary had Texel x Cheviot Mules at £230 twice and £218. Lambed Texel x Mules from Brian Webber of Cullompton sold at £205 twice and £200 twice.

193 NATIVE SHEARLINGS & EWE LAMBS

A eye catching run of impeccably well turned out NC Cheviot shearlings from Sam Pedrick of Bovey Tracey met frenzied bidding and sold in pens of 11's and 12's at £320, £300, £280 & £275 to average £294 of the run, well done Sam. Mark Johnson and Family exhibited a great run of Dorset x Mules which were well received late in the season with three pens selling at £258 and a further five at £248. Brian Grindley of Sampford Courtenay sold Dorset Shearlings at £215 twice and two pens of Dorset Ewe lambs from Messrs Pearce & Sanders of St Neot sold well at £190 & £180.

166 STOCK RAMS & FEMALES (INC SOUTH WEST TEXEL CLUB SALE)

A packed ringside of eager buyers met the great line up of various breeds with trade if anything going dearer and dearer as the sale went on. Great to have the South West Texel Club sale at this fixture for the first time and I think given the results we can confidently say its cemented itself into the calender for years to come! The Texel females were a definite highlight of the day with Malcolm & Kim Coumbe and Family of Housey Farm, Liskeard setting the pace for the sale with outstanding shearling ewes that sold at I I 00gns twice, I 000gns twice and others at 780gns and 750gns, well done to them. Louise Winsor of Beaworthy selling her best shearling ewes at 600gns, 450gns and 400gns twice whilst both Russell Stevens of Crediton and Paul Quick of Zeal Monachorum made 500gns of their best and the I6 shearling ewes within the club sale averaged £666.

Rams from the club breeders sold to a joint top of the day of 1120gns for the pick from the Coumbe Family who had others at 1000gns & 900gns whilst the Quick Family had their best Texel's at 1050gns, 920gns, 900gns and 880gns and Russell Stevens sold his best to 880gns and 800gns. Tom Backway up from Wadebridge sold his pen of Texel Rams to 750gns twice and 700gns and both non MV breeders Phil Bond of Blackawton and Stuart & Jack Winzer of Halwell sold their best at 700gns and the club sale boys averaged £856.

Away from the Texel's and the Quick Family shared the top spot at 1120gns with a powerful CharTex as well as others at 1100gns and 980gns alongside Charollais at 1100gns and 850gns. More CharTex at 1020gns for Anthony Elsworthy of Witheridge and 850gns for Steve & Rachel Lang of Plymouth who also had a pair of Charollais at 820gns. Best of the Suffolk's were sold late in the day, coming from Jack Enticott and Family of Wiveliscombe and making 880gns, 850gns and 800gns with other Suffolk's at 700gns and 680gns from Rachel Lang with both Bernard Strout of Launceston and George Hillson of Yelverton reaching 680gns. Lots of business done between 480gns and 680gns and only a handful of rams less than 350gns to give an overall average of £643 for the boys, coupled with that a clearance rate of 93% and the ram sale was the metaphoric icing on the sheep sale cake!

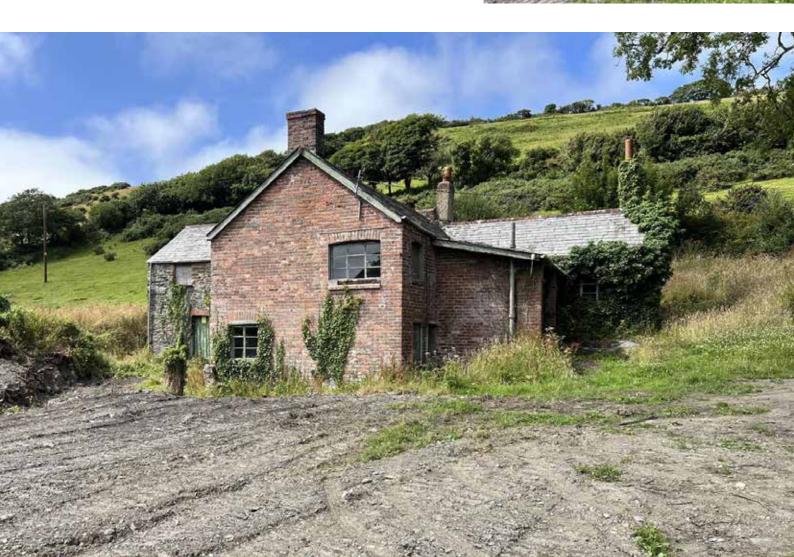

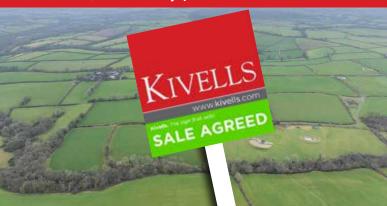
