425 Tractors, Machinery & Effects – Auctioneer: David Kivell & Charlie Kivell

425 lots entered in the online section this month with a 93% clearance and 67% of lots receiving online bids.

A decent lineup of tractors this month with 15 on offer. The top call in this section was £9,200 for a 1996 Massey Ferguson, followed by £9,050 for a 1997 Massey Ferguson G170 with 11,000 hours on the clock. Next up was a David Brown 1390 with loader which topped at £6,400 and came in locally as part of a dispersal. A 1981 John Deere 3040 went under the hammer for £5,200 and following this was a David Brown 885 with a loader which went under the hammer for £4,400 and this was also part of the same local dispersal.

Another impressive lineup of 21 trailers this month with the top call in this section being £5,000 for a JPM dump trailer, following this was a tidy example of a 14ft Indespension tri axle cattle trailer to £3,950 and a Terex 6T dump trailer for £3,700.

The lorry/vehicle section just keeps on giving with a total of 15 cars and 3 lorries on offer. Top shots fired at £10,100 for a 2015 Renault sleeper cab with 565,300km's on the clock, following this was a 2010 Scania R480 in locally topping at £9,200. The top of the vehicles made £5,000 for a 2013 Nissan Navara with 10 months MOT. Next up was a 1995 Land Rover Defender with 84,000 miles on the clock going under the hammer for £4,100.


























756 Smaller Machinery & Goods – Auctioneers: David Kivell & Tim Kivell

It's amazing where all the equipment keeps coming from, another impressive layout of 756 lots of smaller items on the 'top side' here on Saturday. Luckily, we had a dry day which is unusual for Holsworthy. No massive crowd but still a decent 88% clearance.

Top call in the section was £430 given for a scaffolding tower set up. Other items such as an old petrol pump achieved £220, the best of the cement mixers sold well at £150 and a Halfords tool chest also reached £150. Calf feeders sold extremely well to nearly new prices at £150 for some Wydale



feeders with other calf feeders making £135. Granite planters achieved £120, a single David Brown door sold right at the end made its money at £120. Five fence panels made £105 and a lion statue made £100 with its friend the Tiger statue followed at £80. Logs still in strong demand with winter upon us with the best bags of oak split logs reaching £80 per bag with many other dumpy bags of logs present selling between £60 and £75.
