Store Steers to £2570 – Store Heifers to £2320

No great numbers of store cattle coming forward as we enter the month of February when once again the trade held no excuse for keeping them any longer if ready to go. Friday saw tremendous demand right across the board for all on offer and with another packed ringside of buyers in attendance. These stronger cattle changing hands for north of £2000 apiece do look well sold but in line with the finished price whilst all longer term sorts, both good and bad perhaps the trade of the week when we did see some head scratching returns for any of those. Steers sold away to a massive £2570 given for an superb Bunch of five British Blues (25m) from MR, SJ & JE Burrough of Awliscombe with their second pick of Blues still coming back at £2290 for a cracking pen of six (22m). Further decent British Blue bullocks saw solid looking ones (28m) to £2250 for Steve Baker of Kennford and £2180 (24m) for Pat Lee in from Rackenford. Limousin steers up next when more of those very smart red ones (22m) from Brian Vallance and Family of Bickington eased to £2560 whilst Mark Wooldridge from Okehampton saw his quality red Limousin steers of a similar age sold in handy bunches for £2350 and £2340. Also, much later born Limousin bullocks of high stature (14m) from Matthew Wilson of Dunsford looked well sold when drawing £1840. David Harris of Stoke Fleming was back for a third week running with his strong, forward stores and saw his sublime South Devon steer (28m) rise to £2420 and a lovely pair of younger (21m) Herefords reach an impressive £2410 with further eye catching South Devons (22m) from Sue, Geoff and Sean Cleave of Moretonhampstead running to £2310 whilst the same trio also parted with a standout British Blonde steer (21m) for £2410. Michael Vooght was also back again this week selling his first rate Salers cross Charolais, this time seeing wonderful steers (18m) realise £2380 whilst short term Charolais (22m) from David Harris saw £2370 and longer term ones (14m) from Matthew Wilson reached a very decent £2360. Best of the Aberdeen Angus steers (28m) came from Roger Adams up from Newquay and made £2160 followed by younger (20m) Angus at £2110 for David Sluggett and Family from Westwood, Broadclyst. Red Limousin bred heifers filled the top spots in that section with three awesome sorts (22m) from Brian Vallance and Family easing to £2320 followed by others with the same favourable comments and age picking up £2250 and £2200 for Gary Dunn of Okehampton and £2210 for Sue Geoff and Saun Cleave. John Reddaway and Sons in from Cossick Cross parted with a couple of very smart Simmental cross heifers (29m) for £2140 apiece whilst well farmed British Blues (20m) picked up £2100 and £2070 for Toby and Beverley Boys up from East Allington and Dan and Emma Kirk from Ashwater respectively. David Harris sold well turned out heifers (22m) to £2040 for his Hereford and £1930 for Aberdeen Angus followed by other Angus (28m) from Roger Adams which saw £1800. Also, trim Wagyu females (28m) drew £1890 for Earth Products up from Tamerton Foliot. A good selection of cull cows forward on Friday with well-bred and fed South Devons reaching £2220 and £2150 for Phillip and Richard Coaker of Postbridge and grazing types selling to £1780 for a British Blue from Hatherleigh Farms of Bovey Tracey who also sold Hereford crosses to £1730 and Aberdeen Angus cows for £1570.

A mixed entry with very few suckler bred types forward, met another pleasing trade. D & L Ferrett of Bridport topped the section with Simmental cross steers (11m) realising £1380. Josh Webber of Yarcombe sold dairy bred Angus steers (11m) which attained £1320 with Blues a little younger hitting £1260. Chris Hatch of Liskeard sold a good run of dairy bred stirks with Angus steers (12m) topping out at £1210, Charolais steers (11m) hitting £1100, Limousin steers realising £1030 and Blue steers levelling out at £1000. Julie Bullock of Down St Mary sold Simmental cross steers (9m) to £1200 whilst Guy Selleck of Ivybridge presented Charolais crosses (10m) realising £1180. South Devon steers from RT & AR Smaridge of East Allington topped out at £1100 (11m) whilst further dairy bred Blues for RN Giles & Son of Down St Thomas (12m) levelled out at £1030. Young dairy bred types selling exceptionally well with Andrew Webber of Chulmleigh selling Angus steers (5m) to £790 whilst GE Ellett & Son of Littleham sold Charolais cross steers (5m) to £760. Heifers topped out at £990 for dairy bred Blues (12m) from RN Giles & Son whilst Guy Selleck sold Charolais cross heifers (10m) to £980, closely followed by Julie Bullock selling Simmental crosses (10m) to £960. A useful pen of dairy bred Angus heifers from Chris Hatch (12m) topped out at £940 with Limousin heifers off the same good farm achieving £930. Young Blue heifers from Andrew Webber (6m) hit £680 whilst James Dyer of Tavistock sold similar Hereford heifers which achieved the same figure. Further, young dairy bred Angus heifers from Andrew Webber (5m) realised £660 with others to £650. A small show of bulls topped out at £1020 for RT & AR Smaridge selling South Devons whilst dairy bred Blue bulls from James Dyer (6m) levelled out at £800 with Limousin crosses of a similar ilk to £780.

Native calves a strong trade with a good run of young Hereford bulls to £540, £525, £490, £475, £445 & £440 from Mark Boundy of South Molton. Aberdeen Angus bulls to £620 and £540 x 2 with others to £440 for Messrs RH & MJ Hurford. **Heifers topped at £695 x 3** for strong British Blue heifers from James Dyer with others to £675 x 3 for Ray Middleton & Family and young heifers to £535, £525 & £510 for Messrs RH & MJ Hurford, £515 for Stuart Dagworthy and £505 for Phil Humphrey. A young Simmental heifer flew to a serious price at £580 for Messrs MR & KM Pring. Limousin heifers to £570 for James Dyer who also sold Angus heifers at £640. A young Angus heifer at £500 for Ben Roberts & Sam Ball. Hereford heifers to £490 & £420 for Mark Boundy. **Dairy bulls** saw British Friesians to a flying trade topping at £300 with others to £265 & £260 twice all from Ian Pincombe of Crediton and £200 for Messrs RH & MJ Hurford.

“Sheep pens were busting at the seams with a few hundred penned outside but those that were enjoyed a bit of sunshine and a warm trade. 3658 sheep forward and only a few pens of in lambers not sold in loose terms saw 60 orphan lambs average £50, 1700 store hogs averaged £117, nearly 100 grazers averaged £102, the 1600 in lambers averaged £205 and the 76 ewes with their 121 lambs at foot averaged a quite staggering £316 per outfit or £122 per life.”

60 ORPHAN LAMBS

A larger number of orphan lambs but no let up in trade with yet more fresh faces pen side and ready to spend. Geoff and Joe Lang returned to Bishopsteignton chuffed as monkeys to see their best make £75 apiece for a brace as Richard and Angela Smaridge of East Allington sold a pair at £72 and Robert & Edward Mortimer of Kennford sold a pair at £70 plenty of other business between £45 and £65 to level at £49.35 overall.

1697 STORE HOGGS

Hoggs were a typical February entry with something for everyone with many vendors reaching the bottom of the barrel. That said there were also some tidy runs of hoggs and plenty of animated bidding from start to finish particularly for the short and medium keep hoggs. Best hoggs £140 plus with 8 pens over £150 to a top of £158 for Wayne Sanders of Chulmleigh who also had another pen at £153, Valerie Greenfield of Templeton had a single make £157 as Milborne Wick Farms scraped their barrel at £156.50 and W & R Farming of Bradninch sold theirs at £153.50. David and Lynda Pellow of Sourton saw their best make £152 as both Peter Tucker of High Bickington and John May and Family of Bideford reached £150 with their best. Bottom end sorts maybe a bit stickier than the flyer we've seen them for the last month or so and usually £75 to £100 with a few pens sold as seen back from that and all included in that average of £117.22

94 GRAZING EWES

Nearly 100 grazers and the edge just off them with ewes now better sold on a Monday please. Best ewes to £169 for Bondon Farm Partnership of Wellington as the Stephens Family of North Tawton sold a ram at £160 and Graham Heal of High Bickington sold his best pen of crossbred ewes at £154 as well as Mules at £134.

1610 BREEDING EWES

The massive sale of 1600 plus in lamb ewes drew a large crowd of buyers from all across the Westcountry as well as bulk buyers from South Wales and one of the largest buyers on the day all the way down from Anglesey. Buyers were drawn by the large proportion of Mules and they weren't disappointed with all vendors needing congratulating on the great penning of sheep on offer. It was a run late in the sale from Jon Shipton of Holsworthy that provided the highlights with his powerful eye catching NC Mule FM's selling readily at £270 (x4), £268 (x2) and £240 (x5). Robert & Jamie Rogers of Totnes dispersed their March lambing flock to highs of £255 twice and plenty of other business from this home between £210 and £230 with all 475 from this home averaging £211.52. Ian Johnson and Family of Bridport saw their best Texel x Mules make £250 twice, £245 three times as well as the best of their Mules reaching £248 twice and two pens of Suffolk crosses at £235. Edward Hull of Holcombe Rogus had three pens of Mules and a pen of Suffolk crosses reach £232 with plenty of other strong Mules from this home either side of £200 as Andrew Hill of Wells sold flock aged Mules well at £230 twice. Best of a short entry of in lamb hoggs saw Ron Manning of North Tawton make £228 twice and £220 twice with his Mules as Bert Steer of Ashburton claimed £220 of his and Sam Hutchings of Bradninch had Masham's at £180. Leaner or lesser sorts sometimes £160 to £190 and except for a few un entered hill sheep and the empty ewe hoggs there was very few less than £150.

76 EWES & 121 LAMBS (197 LIVES)


Couple trade appears to be getting dearer and dearer each week, imagine the trade when they forecast dry weather! Gary & Helen Woodman surpassed last week's highs with three pens of Dorset doubles over £400 to tops of £428, £422 and £410 whilst Chris and Sue Popham of Trull had a smart Suffolk x double at £400 and a Dorset Mule at £372. Other doubles to £370 for Brian & Clare Westcott of Exford with Emmie Curtis of Cadeleigh selling Charollais ewes with young Texel cross lambs at £362. Plenty of other twins selling between £320 and £360 and only a few staler or leaner backed outfits less than £100 per life. Best singles also coming from Gary & Helen Woodman with their best two pens at £342 followed by the Gillard Family of Drewsteignton with more Dorset singles at £328 and a more common single still looking well sold between £220 and £270. The averages for the couples taking some comprehending at £316 per outfit and £121.97 per life!
