Store Steers to £2560 – Store Heifers to £2250

Fewer store cattle about this week with the tighter supply only helping to make those on offer look very well sold again, all in front of another ringside packed of buyers from both away and closer to home who ensured all types and ages of stores were keenly sought after. Steers sold away to a top of £2560 given for an huge, powerful Devon crossbred (21m) from Steven Slade and Family in from Aylesbeare whilst a tremendous line up of Limousin bullocks was headed by Brian Vallance and Family of Bickington who parted with a pair (20m) for £2400 and a standout single of a similar age for £2340. Other Limousin bred steers worthy of a mention included a smart trio (21m) from JW Davies and Sons from Uplowman at £2250 a life and four more from Steven Slade and Family of the same age which ran to £2240 each. Also much later born Limousin bullocks (15m) sold readily and to £1680 for a pen of five for John Quicke of Coldridge. David Harris, Stoke Fleming followed up last week's high class offering with another lorry load of grand stores and saw his best Hereford steer (20m) reach £2360 and his Charolais (18m) draw £2230 whilst other Charolais and Hereford steers (21m) saw £2360 and £2260 for John Ridd and Family in from Alverdiscott and JW Davies and Sons respectively. Well-bred and famed South Devon steers (23m) from John Hamlin of Bickington eased to a creditable £2280 whilst quality younger South Devon sorts (15m) sold at an impressive £2090 for Phillip and Tom Cleave of Holne. Steven Slade and Family were back when selling tidy Simmental steers (18m) for £2190 as was Brian Vallance and Family when they parted with their strong Aberdeen Angus bullock (20m) for £2150. Plenty of well wintered store heifers about again this week with those topping out at £2250 for a pair of sublime red Limousins (23m) for Gary Dunn of Okehampton with a couple more with the same comments, only younger (20m) also coming back at £2250 for Brian Vallance and Family whilst more younger stores of the highest quality from Phillip and Tom Cleave saw their pen of three Limousin females (14m) return £1940 apiece. Better of the Hereford heifers saw David Harris selling his older (27m) beauty for £2160 and younger (20m) types for £1930 with shapely South Devons (21m) rising to £2150 for Brian Vallance and Family and three eye catching Salers cross Charolais of the same age drawing £2130 a life for Michael Vooght of Hennock. Three quarter meat British Blue heifers (20m) from Steven Slade and Family reached £1980.

A shorter entry met yet another firey trade. Bruce Ellett of Exmouth presented Charolais cross steers (8m) which topped out at £1620 with others of a similar ilk to £1510. Angus steers from Bruce Ellett (8m) levelled out at £1450 with Limousin crosses (8m) out of the same stable hitting £1420. Westcott Farms of Brentor sold Charolais cross steers (7m) which realised £1500 on two occasions with Simmental cross steers off the same good farm hitting £1440. A super run of South Devon steers from Acorn Farms of North Tawton topped out at £1480 (9m) with their second pen a little younger achieving £1380. James Williams of Yelverton presented Charolais cross steers (7m) attaining £1370 whilst dairy bred Blues from RN Giles & Son of Down Thomas (11m) levelled out at £1130. John Camp of Totnes sold a good run of young dairy bred steers with Salers (9m) realising £1070 and young Blues (6m) topping out at £1060 whilst Simmental steers of a similar ilk reached £1020. Heifers a roaring trade with Bruce Ellett selling Charolais crosses (8m) to £1430 with others to £1340 & £1320. Westcott Farms sold Charolais cross heifers (7m) which hit £1350 (x2) whilst James Williams sold further Charolais cross heifers (7m) realising £1220. Dairy bred Blue heifers from the Morris Family of Northlew (13m) attained £1300 whilst further Blue heifers (11m) from RN Giles & Son topped out at £990. John Camp sold Blue heifers (10m) hitting £940 with younger types (6m) to £910 & £810. Trade looking very strong particular for those dairy bred stirk types.

A typical January entry to end the first month of 2026 with just over 2000 sheep forward and sold to respectable trades in all sections. In contrast to last week the 18 orphan lambs met with fireworks as the whole shooting match wouldn't see a lamb over two weeks old but they levelled at £51! Tops of £60 achieved by all nine lambs from Gary and Helen Woodman of Chawleigh to set off a great day at market for the pair!

1491 STORE HOGGS

Almost 1500 store hogs forward and although not quite the quality of last week another tidy show and a trade to match with all lambs looking £3-£5 dearer again on the week. Andy O'Brien of Whimble led the way with a good run of forward Suffolk x Mules that made £155, £154.50, £153.50 & £148 followed closely by Tom Elliott of Winkleigh at £150 & £148 whilst Lyneham Farms of Yealmpton saw the best of their great run make £146.50, £144 & £143 and similar again this week from Victor Pitts of Exminster with his best at £145 & £144. Farming hogs from £125 to £140 with the next cog back normally all £100 plus. A few tail enders sold with faults from £30 to £80 and all included in the overall average of £121.31. Up £2 on the week.

More grazers forward at 245 and a straight trade from start to finish with Andrew Cowling of Taunton topping this week with three Texel rams at £183 and Tom Elliott sold Texel crosses at £162, Suffolk crosses at £161 as well as Mules at £161 & £140. Brian Westcott of Exford sold a Dorset x ewe at £160, Richard and Angela Smaridge of East Allington claimed £156, Gary & Helen Woodman at £140 and Adam Fooks of Weymouth with his best at £139.

83 IN-LAMB EWES

Two consignments of in lambers ahead of next Friday's mammoth sale, saw the flock dispersal of MV & Pedigree Lleyn ewes from Messrs Ayres and Nichols of Umberleigh sell well on the end of the sale and to £245, £235, £232 (x2) and £200 three times, all for mixed aged ewes. Sophie Rowdon of Dartmouth sold her three pens of mainly FM crossbred ewes at £230 and £225 twice. All in average of £221.

76 EWES & 114 LAMBS (190 LIVES)

A slightly larger entry of 76 ewes with their 114 lambs at foot were a pleasing trade throughout with plenty of customers for the goods on offer. Still mainly all Dorset or Dorset cross outfits forward but some great sorts penned today. Gary & Helen Woodman had the first of their annual consignment here today and topped both the singles and doubles with FM Dorset ewes and 3-4 week old CharTex sired lambs selling to £402, £395 & £385 as well as singles to £315, £298, £285 & £280. Graham & Chris Chorley of Chard sold doubles to £382 twice, both Charlie Hutchings of Bradninch and Chris and Sue Popham of Trull made £375 and Craig & Gemma Rowland of North Petherwin attained £365 of theirs. Hylward Farm of Bideford had Dorset shearlings with twins at £362 as well as singles at £272 & £265, more singles at £272 & £268 for Graham & Chris Chorley and £255 for Dave Dicker of Exeter. A few Easycare couples on parade saw the Burrough family of Axminster reach £300 of their best doubles. Overall averages as high as we've seen with outfits levelling at £296.50 and £118.60 per life.
