

Store Steers to £1570 Store Heifers to £1370

Whilst we wait for larger numbers to come forward as the month goes on, we still saw a decent entry of cattle here at Exeter for the first week of the new year and although we do normally expect an uplift in demand at this time, Friday's prices far exceeded expectations with a blistering trade seen for all ages and types on offer. Store steers topped at £1570 given for a well grown Simmental (28m) from Phil Hayman of Ottery st Mary whilst over thirty month steers off the same farm saw pairs of British Blue and Limousins ease to £1510 and £1470 respectively. Younger Limousin bullocks (21m) from Jonathan Strout up from Rilla Mill ran to an impressive £1380 followed by British Blues of a similar age from Jonathan at £1200 and later born Blue steers (14m) from Stephen and Susan saw a trio return £1110. A couple of quality Charolais bred Charolais steers (20m) from Dave Sluggett and Family of Westwood looked well sold at £1270 apiece as did Simmental bullocks (18m) when reaching £1190 for Graham Westaway of Poughill and £1130 for Stuart Broom of Cullompton. Other steer prices of interest included three-quarter grown Herefords (18m) from Jonathan Strout at £1180 apiece, a super bunch of four South Devons (20m) at £1140 a head from Dave Sluggett and Family and three smart Aberdeen Angus (22m) from Nick Maynard, Awliscombe which made £1120 each. Limousins led the way in the heifer section with one (23m) reaching £1370 for Jonathan Lentern in from Chagford and others, a little younger drawing £1230 for Ian Pincombe of Kennerleigh. South Devon females (25m) were well sold when making £1180 for Jonatham Lentern with similar remarks warranted for a pen of four eye catching Aberdeen Angus (20m) which also made £1180 for John Reddaway and Sons of Cossick Cross. A well fed Devon heifer (26m) sold on behalf of Brian Cunningham, Dartington came back at £1120 and young (16m) British Blue heifers from Stephen and Susan Sallis fetched £1070 a life for a pair. Just a few grazing type barren cows on offer this week with the best to £1150 for an aged (14 year old) Charolais cross from JS Parish down from Chawleigh.

Top of the day was £360 for a British Blue bull from Messrs AJ & RH Webber of Cullompton with other young Blues to £345, £315 & £300 for Mr DW Rowe & Son of Axminster, £290 for Messrs DR Searle & Partners of Crediton & £290 for Messrs PA & JK Dymond of Liskeard. Charolais bulls to £315, £285 & £255 for Messrs KF & LW Mitcham of Axminster. Limousin bulls to £255 for Paul & Claire Hendy of Kingsbridge. Native calves looked decent enough value for money topping at £320 x2 for weaned Hereford bulls from Mr O Guest of West Buckland with the best Aberdeen Angus bulls

A dozen orphan lambs flew to £42 for a pair of weaned sorts from Luke Bulley of Ideford whilst young setting on lambs were a crazy trade and either £40 or £41 apiece with Peter French and family of Teignmouth selling five at £41 whilst Brian Westcott of Exford had a pair at the same money and Gary & Helen Woodman of Chawleigh had three youngsters at £40. Overall average of £40.92

1422 STORE HOGGS

Not just as many stores as we were expecting with 1422 penned and sold and selling to a very fast trade with all buyers keen to reinvest after their returns from the last two weeks. A standout run of shorn mainly $\frac{3}{4}$ bred Texels with good frame from Ben Roberts and Sam & Edward Ball of Exmouth commanded sale topping prices with pens at £134, £131, £128.50, £123, £119, £118.50 & £116.50 twice to give them a tremendous average of £117 of 205 sold. ME Stevens & Partners of Okehampton had Suffolk crosses at £123.50 & £116.50 as MP Cleverdon of Black Dog sold his best at £119.50 and Joseph Ley down from Barnstaple saw his Zwartbles make £119. Plenty of short keep hoggs that were by no means fit to kill trading £100 to £115 with medium terms pretty much all £90 plus and those hoggs to come out in April and May nearly all upwards of £78. Hill hoggs still gracing the pens and earning their keep with plenty of interest taking most lots into the £70's and £80 although some Shetland tups, non descript black Welsh and very small questionably bred hoggs all found spirited enquiry and gave us an average of £97.45 overall, up a fiver on last week.

66 GRAZING EWES & RAMS

A small line up saw Jethro Kimber of Merton reach £113 with Zwartbles ewes, a price matched by his parents M&D Kimber with a Ram as well as selling Mules and Dorset's at £96 and Lee Saunders of Liskeard sold his best ram at £110.

549 BREEDING EWES

The first in-lamb sale of the year met with a varied trade for the goods on offer although the best still met decent demand despite the inclement weather. Mark & Henry Johnson of Whitchurch Canonicorum saw the best of the trade with their Texel x one crop ewes selling at £180 twice and £162 whilst their Dorset x Mules of the same age realised £172 and Dorset 6T aged ewes at £155. Their annual consignment of Mule mainly FM ewes met with much interest before the sale and sailed to £172 for the first seven pens with another two at £140, these were all scanned with multiples, whilst their singles proved harder to cash at £100 to £110. James and Mary Jane Campbell of Yealmpton parted with their genuine Dorset type ewes seeing the one crops make £160 x4 and £140 with the older ewes realising £128. Andrew Hendy of Diptford sold crossbred ewes at £140 & £132 as Ray Tucker of Bridford sold FM Mules at £125 & £122 and Chedington Court Estate of Beaminster parted with unscanned April lambing Dorset's for £110, £108 & £104 for the Horns. Others of varying breeds and descriptions under pinned by the strengthening cull trade but perhaps looking value with an overall average of £127 for nearly 550 sold and only a few pens not finding new homes.

33 EWES & 43 LAMBS (76 LIVES)

Couple numbers remaining tight with 33 ewes and their 43 lambs selling to another improved trade with averages of £206 per outfit or £89.53 per life for a very similar show quality wise. Gary & Helen Woodman topping the trade with their pen of FM Dorset doubles realising £272 as well as a smart pen of FM singles, with only young lambs but smart CharTex sired lambs finally making £210 or £105 per life. Other doubles at £240 for GMA Chugg of Farway and £198 for Brian Westcott of Exford who also had singles at £192 & £185 three times as GMA Chugg sold singles at £180 & £168. More needed each week please!
