~ A really good entry of goods despite the weather conditions, attracted a huge crowd for the first Machinery sale of 2019 here at Holsworthy Market ~



202 MACHINERY & GOODS (+VAT) – AUCTIONEER JAMES MORRISH



With no real stars in the sale, top call of the day was £5,100 given for a 60ft steel frame building in from Southwest Steel Ltd. The best of the tractors hit £4,000 for the Kubota going off to Somerset whilst the same vendor sold the John Deere 2140 at £2,400. Messrs Hooper of Crackington Haven sold the International tractor at £1,200. The best of the quad/gators hit £3,100 going off up the M5 whilst the best of several 4x4 vehicles hit £3,200 for the Nissan Nivara (56 reg) going off to Westward Ho!



The Palax wood processor in from South West Woodcrafts raced away to £2,700 with the same vendor selling their log splitter at £470. Ross Sismur of Okehampton sold his livestock container at £580 going off to Exmoor with Robert Partridge of Teignmouth continuing his clearance of livestock equipment topping at £300 for a WM Ironwork creep gate, £270 for yokes & fittings, £200 (x2) for feed barriers, £100 (x2) for cattle troughs and £150 (x8) for Heavy Duty gates.



A mass of trailers topped at £2,500 on behalf of Rydon Mill with the exhibition trailer in from B&B Agri of Gunnislake reaching £1,800 and the best of the 16ft flatbeds to £1,400 in from Winslade Farms, Buckland Brewer. Best of the grassland equipment reached £1,000 for a mower in from Graham Pluess of North Cornwall with several fertilizer spinners ranging from £700-£850.



The best of the grabs, spikes and attachments hit £780 for the Albutt grab in from Glen Rose of Highampton with the straw chopper from Messrs Hooper of Pengold at £800.

General farm machinery topped at £600 for a dung spreader from Steve Beer of Monkleigh with grain equipment to £600.

397 MACHINERY & GOODS (NON VAT) – AUCTIONEER DAVID C KIVELL



A really good entry of just shy of 400 lots attracted a huge crowd and topped at £1,200 for the first of 2 Nuffield tractors in from Mr Northcott of Egloskerry, Launceston with the 2nd one hitting £1,150. Simon Chitty of Coryton sold his single axle calf trailer well at £950 whilst Messrs Tredown Ltd sold the Landrover TD5 (130,000 miles) at £900. Frank Bottomley of Bideford sold his 'S' reg Mitsubishi Showgun at £650 going off to its new home near Winkleigh. Mike Clark sold his 1939 Allis Chalmer (non-runner) at £380 whilst Messrs Gregory of Liddaton hit £260 and their digger bucket at £200 and another vendor went home happy after they sold their terracotta chimney tops for a smoking £120!

A nice line up of surplus goods in from Tinhay Ltd sold well to a top call of £55 for a log burner, £50 for limestone and £50 for a gas blower.

179 PIGS & GOATS – AUCTIONEER JAMES MORRISH



A strong entry of youngstock saw a better than expected trade with the best pigs to £70 on behalf of Tom Hasson of Poughill. Messrs Buckland of Boyton saw their best to £64 with Mike Osbourne of Bradford at £63. Best baby Gloucester Old Spots topped at £60 for Messrs Buckland of Boyton with plenty between £30-£45.

A nice entry of Pedigree Goats were sold on behalf of Messrs Stevens of Temple in Mid Cornwall and topped at £82 with other pens from the same farm at £72 and £62 with wethers to £40 from J Vententen of Inwardleigh, Devon.

542 POULTRY, PET FOOD & EFFECTS – AUCTIONEERS ANDREW VARNEY & TIMMY KIVELL



Big entry of poultry saw a top call of the day being £45(x2) for Peacocks from Messrs Sheridan of Tregnelos.

In other poultry, lot 41 being a pair of Mandarin made £40 whilst their pair of Pied calls also reached the £40 bracket.

Messrs Fricker travelled down from Ringwood in Dorset to sell 300 lots of pet food and effects with a top call of £35 for a livestock model with similar others at £35. Lots of rabbit, cat and dog food between £10-£15 and only a few small lots remained unsold. Also £60 given for a dog cage in from Messrs Smale of Stibb, Cornwall.

A good entry of fodder saw a top call of £41 per bale for hay in from Messrs R&E Sizmur of Okehampton with a small amount of conventional hay at £3.50 per bale from Will Jennings of Torrington, with the same vendor selling conventional barley straw at £3 per bale.
