Another very nice entry today however trade was a little easier than of late. Top call of the day was £11,000 given for the 'J' reg Fiat F100 going off to Dorset whilst the very next lot from Messrs Andrews sold at £4,100 being the 2002 Claas liner rake going off to Challacombe on the top of Exmoor. A mass of trailers topped at £1,050 for the 14ft flatbed trailer in from North Tawton whilst the cattle trailer from Bill Law reached £780 going off to its new home near Southampton. The Honda 2WD quad hit £2,100 whilst the Artic Cat quad (non-running) powered away to £1,500. A tremendous amount of livestock equipment saw Messrs Harpers top the gates and posts at £240 with others at £190 and £160 with calf pens to £280, round feeders to £250 and IAE trough at £190. Robert Partridge of Dawlish saw his IAE docking crush reach £450 and twin hay racks at £110(x2). Messrs Smallacombe of Bow had a nice dispersal following the sale of their farm building and topped at £550 for a weigh crush with gate (race) to £380, sheeted gates to £210 and feed barriers to £140. Roy Askew of Meeth saw his sheep weigher hit £120 with sheep round feeders at £80 and £40.

Top of the day in this section was £900 given for the Marsdon trailer (26 years old) for Messrs Waterman of Monkleigh near Bideford. Lots of cars and vans included the 2003 Freelander in from Steve Urquhart reaching £475. Messrs James of Stowford saw his best lot to £100 for pallet forks with milk churns from Messrs Sizmur at £70.

The dispersal of woodworking equipment from Mrs Sampson topped at £220 for the electric saw and £210 for the planner.
