The John Deere butterfly mowers sold at £12,000 going off to Mid Cornwall with the '02 plate John Deere handler hitting £9,500. The pick of the 11 trailers topped at £5,000 for the Marston trailer going off to Mid Devon with the John Deere mower hitting £3,450.



Toby & Angella Ansdell sold their livestock trailer well at £1,900 with the best of 14 loaders topping at £2,500 on behalf of Messrs Chugg. A good number of static caravans topped at £1,900 going off to Berryharbour with Geoff Hutchings. Plenty of machinery between £800-£1,300 with a 78% clearance on the day.
